He describes his progression from inexperienced novice to veteran flyer as he learned his trade under combat conditions. McNaul, 2005-10-07 The story begins with the author as a child getting an unwitting education in the ways of moving water by playing in the creek that flowed by his boyhood home. The McNaul residence was located between a railroad embankment and a highway, which were confining borders for a kid growing up. Finally, aging and being permitted beyond these barriers led to the discovery of canoeing. The first trials and errors of boating and a slow advance to different types of canoe trips are covered in the text. Then a birthday
