The result was the area bombing strategy which focussed attacks upon enemy held towns and cities This Main Offensive period lasted throughout 1943 1944 and saw both victories and defeats It was also the period that saw a limited number of precision attacks on Augsburg Peenemunde and most famously the Ruhr dams Bomber Command also aided in tactical and strategic support for the invasion of Europe and the subsequent fight to push inland New technological developments allowed Bomber Command to hit V Weapons sites and to focus more on precision bombing but Harris remained determined to hit German towns and cities whenever possible while the Command's growing power allowed it to rain devastation upon its targets culminating at Dresden Much has been written about Bomber Command but this book focusses largely on those who took part in the raids and on public attitudes towards the campaign in Britain Using accounts from national and local archives newspapers and existing historiography the book seeks to shed light on untold stories from Bomber Command's war **The Heavy Bomber Offensive of WWII** Martin W.
