Classes on Modern Poets and the Art of Poetry James Dickey, 2004 Housman Gerard Manley Hopkins Robert Frost Walter Facades John Pearson, 2011-12-01 First published in 1978 Fa ades details the lives of de la Mare and Robert Bridges three of the twentieth century s most intriguing literary figures Edith Osbert and Sacheverell Sitwell Aristocrats emanating from a privileged but loveless youth they moulded the scene of the English avant garde throughout the 1920s and in Cyril Connolly s words had they not been there a whole area of life would have been missing Picking up prot g s and starting feuds with equal alacrity they were never far from controversy and were often slighted for being better known for the fa ades which they put up around their work rather than their artistic out put in itself Whether these fa ades were set up to hide their art or their deeply conflicted personal lives is one of the most compelling problems brought up by Pearson With as much attention paid to both the private and public aspects of their lives this biography captures the manifest intrigue of one of England's strangest and most flamboyant families and the whole host of fascinating characters from T S Eliot to Gertrude Stein with whom their paths intersect The Poetry of the Self-taught Julie D. Prandi, 2008 The Poetry of the Self Taught demonstrates the characteristic strengths of self taught poetry and analyzes the factors that have caused most selftaught poets to disappear from anthologies and from literary history Raising the question of whether or not their work should be read today and taken seriously instead of being relegated to separate and unequal categories like women s or peasant poetry the book highlights interesting contrasts between the poetry of eighteenth century autodidacts such as Robert Burns Mary Leapor C D F Schubart and Anna Louise Karsch and the work of their contemporaries mainstream poets like Alexander Pope James Thomson C F Gellert and Barthold Heinrich Brockes Self taught poetry is often treated as an index to the lives and times of the poets but this book explores it with a different purpose to understand and illustrate the commonalities in autodidactic poetics imagery rhetorical strategies and themes Concurrent with a recent upturn of interest in laboring or self taught poets both in England and in Germany The Poetry of the Self Taught will be useful for courses focusing on such poets or those dealing with eighteenth century literature The Defense of Poesy, Otherwise Known as An Apology for Poetry Philip Sidney, 1890 Parliament and Political Pamphleteering in Fourteenth-century England Clementine Oliver, 2010 Sixty years before the advent of the printing press the first political pamphlets about parliament were circulated in the city of London These handwritten pamphlets reported on victories against the crown and point to the existence of a market of readers hungry for news of parliament The Greatest Christmas Tales & Poems in One Volume (Illustrated) Louisa May Alcott, O.
