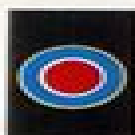

father of the RAF Lord Trenchard was determined that it should become a fully fledged third service equal in status to the Royal Navy and British Army and this he succeeded in doing between the wars firstly by setting up the RAF College at Cranwell and Staff College at Andover and secondly by providing a cost effective policeman of the more rebellious parts of the British Empire By 1939 the RAF had grown substantially but of the three best aircraft of the coming War only the Supermarine Spitfire was in service as neither the Avro Lancaster nor the De Havilland Mosquito would be available until early 1942 Aircraft however were not enough It was the leaders of the RAF the subjects of this book who would take the battle to the enemy and who after six long years would prevail **Among the Dead Cities** A. C. Grayling, 2014-04-24 Is it ever right to target civilians in a time of war Or do the ends sometimes justify the means The twentieth century the age of total war marked the first time that civilian populations came to be seen as legitimate military targets At this policy's most terrible extreme came the dropping of the atomic bomb on Hiroshima and Nagasaki but it is an issue that remains relevant today with the needs of the War on Terror used to justify the use of drone strikes In *Amongst the Dead Cities* A C Grayling explores these moral issues in all their complexity with a detailed examination of the Allied bombing of German cities during World War 2 Considering the cases for and against the area bombing and the experiences of the bombed and the bombers Grayling asks was the targeting of civilians in Germany a crime Now available in the Bloomsbury Revelations series the book includes a new afterword by the author considering the issues in light of later conflicts up to the present day

Dambuster-in-Chief Richard Mead, 2020-12-30 A fascinating biography of one of the most important figures in Bomber Command during the Second World War History of War Ralph Cochrane was born in 1895 into a distinguished naval family After joining the Royal Navy he volunteered in 1915 to serve with the RNAS in airships and was an early winner of the Air Force Cross In 1918 he transferred to the fledgling RAF and learned to fly serving in Iraq as a flight commander under Bomber Harris His inter war career saw him as a squadron commander in Aden before he became the first Chief of Air Staff of the Royal New Zealand Air Force During the Second World War he served mainly in Bomber Command and commanded 5 Group from early 1943 He formed 617 Squadron and was instrumental in planning the legendary Dambuster Raid the most spectacular of the War as well as the sinking of the battleship Tirpitz An inspirational leader he trained 5 Group in low level target marking skills Post war Cochrane held a string of senior appointments commanding Transport Command Flying Training Command and finally as Vice Chief of Air Staff retiring in 1952 He died in 1977 A brilliantly researched biography of a fascinating fighter adds a new name to rank alongside Great Britain's most heroic warriors Argunners The Dambusters is one of my absolute favourite stories from WWII and this bio of Cochrane tells the story of an extraordinary man Brilliant Books Monthly *The Hidden Army - MI9's Secret Force and the Untold Story of D-Day* Matt Richards, 2018-07-05 Almost seventy five years ago MI9 dreamt up the most audacious escape and evasion plan of World War Two Formulated by Airey Neave one of the first men ever to escape from Colditz this plan was one of subterfuge concealment and deception on a scale

never seen before With numerous downed RAF and Allied pilots on the run in Europe and with the fabled Comete Escape Line having been infiltrated by double agents Neave's plan was to hide these men right under the very noses of the Nazis rather than risk repatriation Choosing a forest in the heart of France right next to one of the German Army's largest ammunition bases Neave, Belgian agents and the French Resistance would secretly transport and hide Allied pilots and soldiers within feet of the enemy Nobody thought it would work but such was the success of the secret camp that a whole community of over one hundred and fifty Allied escapers lived within the forest for three months in the run up to D Day Despite numerous close shaves they were never discovered and this outrageous plan brilliant in its simplicity saw the Allied evaders make their home in the forest cooking and hunting to survive and even setting up a golf course in the forest using branches for clubs without discovery This operation remained absolutely secret to the point that the inhabitants of the villages surrounding the forest were unaware until the end of the existence of that allied force so close to them Told through interviews with evaders members of the Resistance and the children charged with smuggling food into the forest this book tells the compelling story of one of the most audacious operations in World War Two A story that has until today remained as secret as the Hidden Army of Freteval

Wartime airfields can be very atmospheric places When you stand at Gransden Lodge at dusk it's very easy to imagine a huge Lancaster bomber taxiing out onto a runway for takeoff Today the peaceful countryside to the west of Cambridge is mainly given over to agriculture but for several years in the mid 20th century things were very different Then the area was dotted with airfields from which Allied aircraft flew to war and one of these was Gransden Lodge When the airfield first became operational the units that were stationed there were involved in top secret radar investigation and trials work but within a year these units had moved away and the station became the base of the only Canadian squadron in the R A F's elite Pathfinder Force It was later joined by another Pathfinder Force squadron and together they flew many hazardous missions in all weathers against the Axis After the war's end Gransden Lodge was briefly used by a unit that pioneered radar assisted airborne mapping and as a base for transport aircraft It was subsequently the venue for some of the first post war motor races in the U K and for many years before its decommissioning was under consideration as a Cold War base for American forces In the early 1990s the wheel came full circle and flying began again when Gransden Lodge became the home of one of Britain's leading gliding clubs Over the space of more than seventy years Gransden Lodge has seen aviation in many forms ranging from secret trials and heavy bomber operations to competitive gliding World renowned servicemen and scientists have passed through its gates and many whose names are now almost forgotten lost their lives after taking off from its runways Trials and Tribulation is the story of this historic airfield and it will appeal to those interested in military and aviation history
