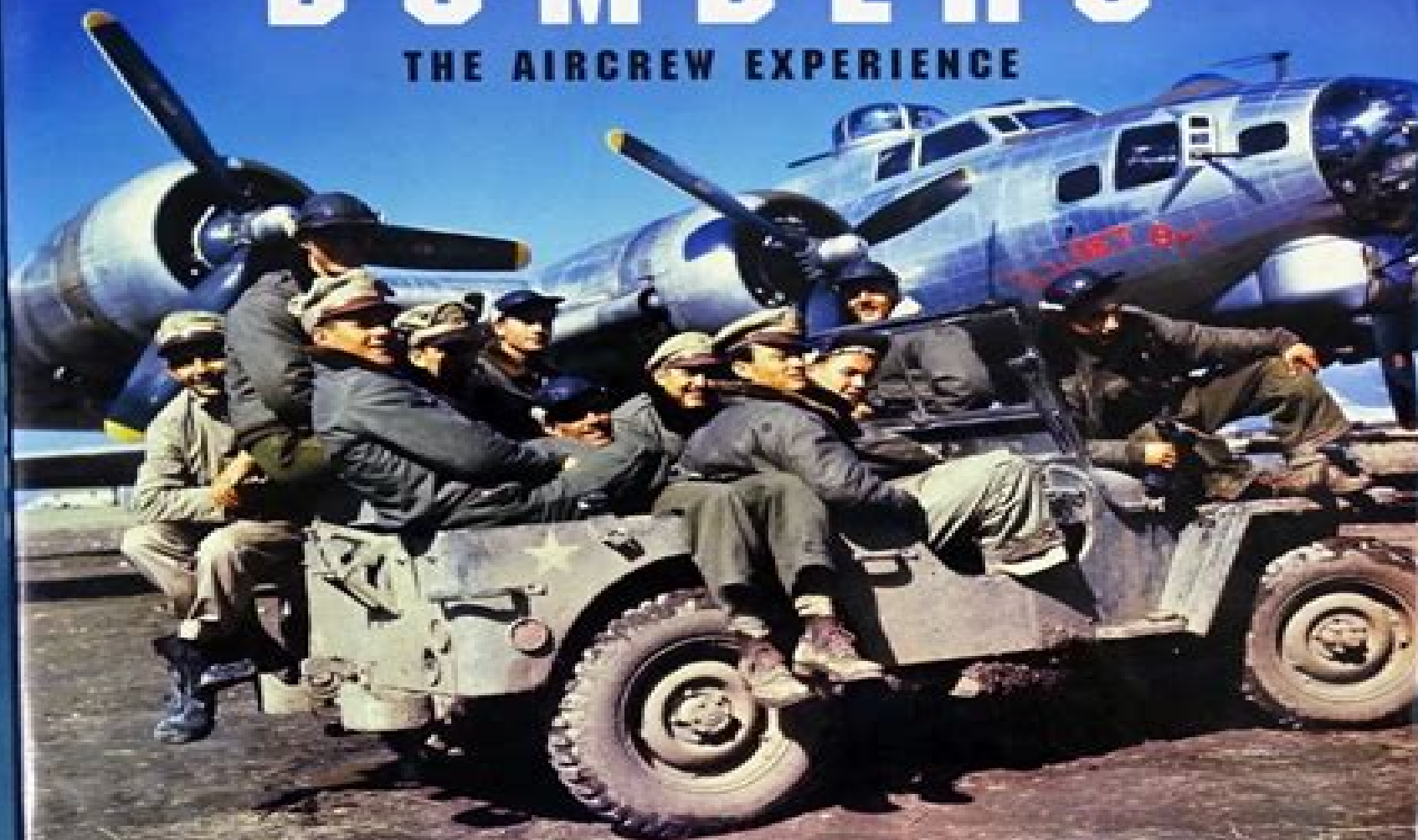

The RAF's Youngest Bomber Pilot of WW2 Graham

Waterton, 2024-08-30 Having left his grammar school just before his 16th birthday Brian Slade falsified his age to pursue his dream of becoming a pilot Within a few days of his 17th birthday he was awarded his wings It was the start of this teenager's remarkable wartime career Soon after being awarded his pilot's brevet Brian was posted to his first squadron Flying the venerable Vickers Wellington he found himself experimenting with early target marking techniques It was also there that Brian gained the nickname The Boy Slade Though Brian's journey through the wartime RAF mirrored the experiences of tens of thousands of young men what was different if not unique was the fact before he had turned 18 which was the minimum age to begin aircrew training Brian had already completed thirty four operations more than was needed for a tour This tally included the three 1 000 bomber raids against Cologne Essen and Bremen He was awarded a Distinguished Flying Cross for nursing his badly damaged Wellington which sustained flak and night fighter damage home after a raid on Bremen Undaunted Brian soon after volunteered for his second tour of operations It was at this stage that he joined the Lancaster

equipped 83 Squadron in the newly formed 8 Group becoming an experienced Pathfinder skipper It was a role in which he marked targets in the Battle of the Ruhr the bombing of Hamburg Operation Gomorrah and the Peenemünde raid The RAF's Youngest Bomber Pilot of WW2 told by his nephew a former officer in the British Army details all of Brian's fifty nine missions and captures his compelling progress with Bomber Command alongside the technological advances in aircraft pathfinder strategy and tactics Sadly Brian's Lancaster was shot down over Berlin in August 1943 The details of its loss remained shrouded in mystery until the puzzle of his aircraft's demise was eventually solved by tracing the family of the only survivor The relentless dangers not just in operations but also in training and the continuous loss of life are drawn into sharp focus But on account of his age Brian's story is unique There may have never been nor will ever be an RAF pilot of 19 years old with his flying and operational experience Complemented with a collection of previously unpublished photographs The RAF's Youngest Bomber Pilot of WW2 is one of the Second World War's most amazing tales **Realistic Bomber Training**

and dive bombers the latter hampered by a gunner's turret and most unsuited for modern warfare. However, 806 was fortunate to have at its head the volatile but skilful and aggressive Lt Cdr Charles Evans, a 30-year-old born leader with ten years' experience flying with both the RAF and RN. With the aid of his equally experienced Senior Observer Lt Desmond Vincent Jones, the young fledgling pilots, mainly straight from training school, were soon receiving expert instruction. Having survived early ops over Norway and Dunkirk, 806 was selected to fly the new fleet fighter, the underrated Fulmar, with which it went to war in the Mediterranean aboard the aircraft carrier *Illustrious* and won its spurs. The young pilots, led by the CO, wreaked havoc amongst the Italian navy's spotter seaplanes and bombers. This is their story.

D-Day Bombers Stephen Darlow, 2014-07-19. This book is largely an eye-witness account of the heavy bomber contribution to the success of the D-Day landings and therefore to the winning of the war in Europe. It is told using considerable first-hand experience from the veterans of the campaign, something not really covered in any other books on the subject, together with background information from primary source documents on the tactics and strategy employed. Eight different aircrews, five RAF and three USAAF, tell widely differing stories of operations before, during and after D-Day. Their vivid and dramatic accounts are supplemented by numerous contributions from other aircrew and ground crew veterans, army personnel and French civilians which have been carefully gathered by Stephen Darlow from interviews with veterans and their relatives through correspondence and contemporary diaries. Certain raids have been selected and described in detail and there are numerous previously unpublished photographs. As Winston Churchill wrote: 'This is no war of chieftains or of princes of dynasties or national ambition; it is a war of peoples and of causes. There are vast numbers not only in this island but in every land who still render faithful service in the war but whose names will never be known, whose deeds will never be recorded. Here is their story, sixty years on.'

Fighter Drawdown Dynamics William W. Taylor, J. H. Bigelow, John A. Ausink, 2009. Even though the number of fighter aircraft in the Air Force inventory is decreasing, the demand for experienced fighter pilots is increasing because new nonflying staff positions are thought to require people with fighter skills. The authors use a dynamic mathematical model to show that under current conditions and management practices, fighter units are unable to absorb enough new pilots that is, provide enough flying hours to give them the experience they need to meet the increased demand and that attempting to do so can decrease unit readiness. They also show how increasing credit for simulator training, new approaches to developing fighter pilot-like skills such as unmanned aerial systems and the integrated use of active guard and reserve fighter aircraft for pilot development can help the Air Force meet the increased demand for staff personnel with fighter pilot skills while maintaining the health of its fighter units.

THE PHYSIOLOGICAL AND PSYCHOLOGICAL EFFECTS OF COMBAT STRESS EXPERIENCED BY THE HEAVY BOMBARDMENT CREWS OF THE EIGHTH AIR FORCE DURING WWII Anthony Cardo, 2025-02-21. *The Physiological and Psychological Effects of Combat Stress Experienced by the Heavy Bombardment Crews of the Eighth Air Force during WWII* offers a unique window into the effects

of combat stress as experienced by a select number of men in a select moment of time and one that is unlikely to be experienced again by mankind This is not to say that future combat aviators will not experience the unique effects of combat stress as this is nearly a given as the record of man s wartime experiences shows but that the unique environment the men of the Eighth Air Force experienced will likely not be repeated to the same degree going forward With that being the most likely case author and military historian Anthony Cardio seeks to also explore what the experiences of the heavy bombardment crews of the Eighth Air Force with the physiological and psychological effects of combat stress have to offer posterity and aims to inspire the reader to ask for themselves what these experiences have to offer posterity What this work is not is a clinical study on the bomber crewmen nor is it meant to be an exhaustive study on the subject Instead it is meant to add to the historical discussion by categorizing some of the various physiological and psychological symptoms of combat induced fear and providing commentary on its significance and relation to the wider literature on the effects of combat stress on human beings If the work succeeds in fueling your interest or curiosity on the topic and propels you into further research then it has at least succeeded in its overall goal to both raise awareness and the discussion on the topic I hope you enjoy it as I enjoyed both researching and drafting this work

December 8, 1941 William H. Bartsch, 2012-08-13 Ten hours after the attack on Pearl Harbor another Pearl Harbor of even more devastating consequence for American arms occurred in the Philippines 4 500 miles to the west On December 8 1941 at 12 35 p m 196 Japanese Navy bombers and fighters crippled the largest force of B 17 four engine bombers outside the United States and also decimated their protective P 40 interceptors The sudden blow allowed the Japanese to rule the skies over the Philippines removing the only effective barrier that stood between them and their conquest of Southeast Asia This event has been called one of the blackest days in American military history How could the army commander in the Philippines the renowned Lt Gen Douglas MacArthur have been caught with all his planes on the ground when he had been alerted in the small hours of that morning of the Pearl Harbor attack and warned of the likelihood of a Japanese strike on his forces In this book author William H Bartsch attempts to answer this and other related questions Bartsch draws upon twenty five years of research into American and Japanese records and interviews with many of the participants themselves particularly survivors of the actual attack on Clark and Iba air bases The dramatic and detailed coverage of the attack is preceded by an account of the hurried American build up of air power in the Philippines after July 1941 and of Japanese planning and preparations for this opening assault of its Southern Operations Bartsch juxtaposes the experiences of staff of the U S War Department in Washington and its Far East Air Force bomber fighter and radar personnel in the Philippines who were affected by its decisions with those of Japan s Imperial General Headquarters in Tokyo and the 11th Air Fleet staff and pilots on Formosa who were assigned the responsibility for carrying out the attack on the Philippines five hundred miles to the south In order to put the December 8th attack in broader context Bartsch details micro level personal experiences and presents the political and strategic aspects of American and Japanese

planning for a war in the Pacific Despite the significance of this subject matter it has never before been given full book length treatment This book represents the culmination of decades long efforts of the author to fill this historical gap **A**
