*Good Trouble* Joe Biel, 2016-03-15 The history of Microcosm Publishing from its origins as a record label and zine distro in Joe Biel s bedroom closet in Cleveland to a thriving sustainable publisher of life changing books The book comes out to mark Microcosm s 20th anniversary and all the shit and splendor that s gone into making us who we are In 1996 everything about Joe Biel s life seemed like a mistake He was 18 he lived in Cleveland he got drunk every day and he had mystery health problems and weird social tics All his friends lives were as bad or worse To escape a nihilistic apocalyptic worldview and to bring reading and documentation into a communal punk scene he started assembling self published misfit zines and bringing them in milk crates to underground punk shows As he applied the economics and values of underground punk rock music to publishing books his worldview expanded along with his business and so did the punk community s idea of what was possible Eventually this became Microcosm Publishing But all was not rosy Biel s head for math was stronger than his ability to relate to people and for everything that added up right more things broke down He developed valuable skills and workarounds but it wasn t until he was diagnosed with Asperger s Syndrome that it all began to fall into place *Good Trouble* is a tale of screwing up trying again and always finding a way do it better It s a book for anyone who has ever failed big and dreamed bigger It s about developing a toolkit for turning your difficulties into superpowers building the world that you envision and inspiring others to do the same This is the story of how over 20 years one person turned a litany of continuing mistakes and seemingly wrong turns into a happy fulfilled life and a thriving publishing business that defies all odds With a foreword by Sander Hicks founder of Soft Skull Press and an introduction by Joyce Brabner co author with Harvey Pekar of *Our Cancer Year*

**Gender in the Music Industry** Marion Leonard, 2017-10-03 Why despite the number of high profile female rock musicians does rock continue to be understood as masculine Why is rock generally assumed to be created and performed by men Marion Leonard explores different representations of masculinity offered by and performed through rock music and examines how female rock performers negotiate this gendering of rock as masculine A major concern of the book is not specifically with men or with women performing rock but with how notions of gender affect the everyday experiences of all rock musicians within the context of

the music industry Leonard addresses core issues relating to gender rock and the music industry through a case study of female centred bands from the UK and US performing so called indie rock from the 1990s to the present day Using original interview material with both amateur and internationally renowned musicians the book further addresses the fact that the voices of musicians have often been absent from music industry studies Leonard s central aim is to progress from feminist scholarship that has documented and explored the experience of female musicians to presenting an analytic discussion of gender and the music industry In this way the book engages directly with a number of under researched areas the impact of gender on the everyday life of performing musicians gendered attitudes in music journalism promotion and production the responses and strategies developed by female performers the feminist network riot grrrl and the succession of international festivals it inspired under the name of Ladyfest

*Intimate Ephemera* Anna Poletti, 2008 *Intimate Ephemera* is the first major study of autobiographical writing produced and consumed in a youth subculture Investigating the uses of the zine form for life writing it examines the recurrent themes in texts circulating in Australian zine culture including depression consumerism popular culture and political identity *Intimate Ephemera* also examines zine culture as a unique community of life writing and reading where handmade texts circulate in an economy of gifting and exchange utilising the postal system The book analyses the material diversity of zines as handmade objects examining the use of the photocopier and craft techniques in these limited edition publications bringing a focus to the role of the text object in communicating personal experience
