The Israelites kept the Sabbath morning to morning in Ex 16 and the rest of Old Testament history is consistent with this reckoning. The New Testament throughout its pages likewise reckons days to start in the morning. The Temple in the New Testament counted the hours of the day from 6 A.M. The disciples buying of spices in the evening after the death of Jesus is shown to be inconsistent with an evening-to-evening reckoning of the Sabbath. Christ celebrates the Lord's Day in Jn 20:19 with the disciples in the evening of the 1st day of the week which the apostles continued to practice in Acts 20:7-11. The corruption of the Sabbath by Jewish traditionalism in keeping the Sabbath from evening to evening likely started in the inter-Testamental era and was preserved in their Talmuds.
