Courtesans Day:

A Courtesan's Day Cecilia Segawa Seigle, 2004 A courtesan's day in the carefree atmosphere of the famous pleasure quarter the Yoshiwara in Edo present day Tokyo was carefully planned to an hourly schedule This sequence of twelve and later twenty four hours proved a convenient device for Japanese print artists and their publishers when devising sets of prints showing favorite beauties of the day engaged in daily activities. This volume presents three prints series on the same theme produced over the course of a century Besides being an obvious aid to collectors of these sets it also provides a fascinating insight into the world of the female entertainer in Edo and later Tokyo The book opens with Cecilia Seigle's comprehensive introduction to life in this highly structured and tightly controlled pleasure quarter offering insights into the often hard and occasionally glamorous life of the courtesan in eighteenth and nineteenth century Edo The first series treated here Utamaro s famous Twelve Hours in Yoshiwara Seir j ni toki tsuzuki c 1794 is shown in all its glory with descriptions by Tim Clark Keeper of Japanese Antiquities at the British Museum We then leap forward in time to the Meiji period when the status of women in Japanese society and particularly those in the Yoshiwara underwent substantial change Alfred Marks discusses Yoshitoshi s set Twenty four hours in Shinbashi and Yanagibashi Shinry nij shi toki 1880 with translations of the copious textual information on the prints Amy Newland concludes by examining Toyohara Kunichika's interpretation of the theme of twenty four hours as represented in his set The scenes of the twenty four hours parodied Mitate ch ya nij yoji no uchi 1890 The Courtesan's Arts Martha Feldman, Bonnie Gordon, 2006-03-23 Courtesans hetaeras tawaif s ji s these women have exchanged artistic graces elevated conversation and sexual favors with male patrons throughout history and around the world In Ming dynasty China and early modern Italy exchange was made through poetry speech and music in pre colonial India through magic music chemistry and other arts Yet like the art of courtesanry itself those arts have often thrived outside present day canons and modes of transmission and have mostly vanished without trace The Courtesan's Arts delves into this hidden legacy while touching on its equivocal relationship to geisha At once interdisciplinary empirical and theoretical the book is the first to ask how arts have figured in the survival or demise of courtesan cultures by juxtaposing research from different fields Among cases studied by writers on classics ethnomusicology anthropology and various histories of art music literature and political culture are Ming dynasty China twentieth century Korea Edo and modern Japan ancient Greece early modern Italy and India past and present Refusing a universal model the authors nevertheless share a perception that courtesans hover in the crevices of space time and practice between gifts and money courts and cities subtlety and flamboyance feminine allure and masculine power as wifely surrogates but keepers of culture What most binds them to their arts in our post industrialized world of global services and commodities they find is courtesans fragility as their cultures once vital to civilizations founded in leisure and pleasure are now largely forgotten transforming courtesans into national icons or historical curiosities or reducing them to prostitution Keisai Eisen A Tōkaidō Board Game of Courtesans Cristina

Berna, Eric Thomsen, Introduction Keisai Eisen 1790 1848 is especially known for his bijin ga pretty women and landscapes He is well known for his participation in the series 69 stations of the Nakasend together with Hiroshige The series A T kaid Board Game of Courtesans Fifty three Pairings in the Yoshiwara use the T kaid with landscape inserts as an excuse for showing courtesans and geisha bijin ga to skirt the censorship It was published 1821 1823 His bijin ga are considered to be masterpieces of the decadent Bunsei Era 1818 1830 Most of them have impressive hairdo with many ornamental hairpins and combs Their dress is extravagant with beautiful patterns and sublime embroideries Their faces are elongated squares with long noses and small pouted painted mouths Courtesans were desirable for their rich and splendid attire not so much for their beauty and their names were actually like trademarks for a series of girls performing the name role with the brothel in question **Dangerous Pleasures** Gail Hershatter, 2023-09-01 This pioneering work examines prostitution in Shanghai from the late nineteenth century to the present Drawn mostly from the daughters and wives of the working poor and declass elites prostitutes in Shanghai were near the bottom of class and gender hierarchies Yet they were central figures in Shanghai urban life entering the historical record whenever others wanted to appreciate castigate count regulate cure pathologize warn about rescue eliminate or deploy them as a symbol in a larger social panorama Over the past century prostitution has been understood in many ways as a source of urbanized pleasures a profession full of unscrupulous and greedy schemers a changing site of work for women a source of moral danger and physical disease a marker of national decay and a sign of modernity For the Communist leadership of the 1950s the elimination of prostitution symbolized China's emergence as a strong healthy and modern nation In the past decade as prostitution once again has become a recognized feature of Chinese society it has been incorporated into a larger public discussion about what kind of modernity China should seek and what kind of sex and gender arrangements should characterize that modernity Prostitutes like every other non elite group did not record their own lives How can sources generated by intense public argument about the larger meanings of prostitution be read for clues to those lives Hershatter makes use of a broad range of materials guidebooks to the pleasure quarters collections of anecdotes about high class courtesans tabloid gossip columns municipal regulations prohibiting street soliciting police interrogations of streetwalkers and those accused of trafficking in women newspaper reports on court cases involving both courtesans and streetwalkers polemics by Chinese and foreign reformers learned articles by Chinese scholars commenting on the world history of prostitution and analyzing its local causes surveys by doctors and social workers on sexually transmitted disease in various Shanghai populations relief agency records fictionalized accounts of the scams and sufferings of prostitutes memoirs by former courtesan house patrons and interviews with former officials and reformers Although a courtesan may never set pen to paper we can infer a great deal about her strategizing and working of the system through the vast cautionary literature that tells her customers how not to be defrauded by her Newspaper accounts of the arrests and brief court testimonies of Shanghai streetwalkers let us glimpse the way that prostitutes positioned themselves to

Lindsey, 2006-11-30 As their ubiquitous presence in Tokugawa nineteenth century China artwork and literature suggests images of bourgeois wives and courtesans took on iconic status as representations of two opposing sets of female values Their differences both real and idealized indicate the full range of female roles and sexual values affirmed by Tokugawa society with Buddhist celibacy on the one end and the relatively free sexual associations of the urban and rural lower classes on the other The roles of courtesan and bourgeois housewife were each tied to a set of value based behaviors the primary institution to which a woman belonged and rituals that sought to model a woman's comportment in her interactions with men and figures of authority For housewives it was fertility values promulgated by lifestyle guides and moral texts which embraced the ideals of female obedience loyalty to the husband's household and sexual activity aimed at producing an heir Pleasure values by contrast flourished in the prostitution quarters and embraced playful relations and nonreproductive sexual activity designed to increase the bordello s bottom line What William Lindsey reveals in this well researched study is that although the values that idealized the role of wife and courtesan were highly disparate the rituals symbols and popular practices both engaged in exhibited a degree of similitude and parallelism Fertility and Pleasure examines the rituals available to young women in the household and pleasure quarters that could be employed to affirm transcend or resist these sets of sexual values In doing so it affords new views of Tokugawa society and Japanese religion

Highly original in its theoretical approach and its juxtaposition of texts Fertility and Pleasure constitutes an important addition to the fields of Japanese religion and history and the study of gender and sexuality in other societies and cultures
