Ten Thousand Things on China and the Chinese Barnum's Chinese Museum, 1850 **Kingdom of Ten Thousand Things** Gary Geddes, 2012-02-07 From war torn Afghanistan through the snow capped Himalayas and across the burning sands of the Taklamakan desert to a rapidly modernizing China and on to the Central American jungles it seems an impossible journey but one that Gary Geddes eagerly undertook in order to retrace the voyage of the legendary 5th century Buddhist monk Huishen Geddes was long fascinated with stories of Huishen's life and travels this Afghan holy man fled Kabul for China and may have crossed the Pacific to North America 1 000 years before Columbus The length and breadth of this expedition and its difficulty would have been amazing enough on its own but Geddes's trip takes on an added dimension and poignancy due to its timing he reaches Afghanistan one month before September 11 2001 and arrives in China as the tragic events unfold Along the way Geddes encounters Afghan refugees Pakistani dissidents Tibetan monks Buddhist scholars a KFC outlet in Luoyang mysterious cairns in Haida Gwaii and ghostly remains in Mexico As the Silk Road morphs into superhighways ancient sculptures turn into military targets Geddes glimpses in the collision of past and present history important clues for imagining a workable future **Critical Sermons of the Zen Tradition** Shin'ichi

The Pristine Dao Thomas Michael, 2012-02-01 The Laozi Daodejing and the Zhuangzi have long been familiar to Western

readers and have served as basic sources of knowledge about early Chinese Daoism. Modern translations and studies of these works have encouraged a perception of Daoism as a mystical philosophy heavy with political implications that advises kings to become one with the Dao. Breaking with this standard approach, *The Pristine Dao* argues that the Laozi and the Zhuangzi participated in a much wider tradition of metaphysical discourse that included a larger corpus of early Chinese writings. This book demonstrates that early Daoist discourse possessed a distinct textually constituted coherence and a religious sensibility that starkly differed from the intellectual background of all other traditions of early China, including Confucianism. The author argues that this discourse is best analyzed through its emergence from the mythological imagination of early China and that it was unified by a set of notions about the Dao that was shared by all of its participants. The author introduces certain categories from the Western religious and philosophical traditions in order to bring out the distinctive qualities constituting this discourse and to encourage its comparison with other religious and philosophical traditions. Yong Huang, 2014-10-07 Yong Huang presents a new way of doing comparative philosophy as he demonstrates the resources for contemporary ethics offered by the Cheng brothers, Cheng Hao (1032-1085) and Cheng Yi (1033-1107), canonical neo-Confucian philosophers. Huang departs from the standard method of Chinese-Western comparison, which tends to interest those already interested in Chinese philosophy. While Western-oriented scholars may be excited to learn about Chinese philosophers who have said things similar to what they or their favored philosophers have to say, they hardly find anything philosophically new from such comparative work. Instead of comparing and contrasting philosophers, each chapter of this book discusses a significant topic in Western moral philosophy, examines the representative views on this topic in the Western tradition, identifies their respective difficulties, and discusses how the Cheng brothers have better things to say on the subject. Topics discussed include why one should be moral, how weakness of will is not possible, whether virtue ethics is self-centered, in what sense the political is also personal, how a moral theory can be of an antitheoretical nature, and whether moral metaphysics is still possible in this postmodern and postmetaphysical age.
