- **Intrapersonal communication:** communication within an individual. It is each person's "self-talk", the internal discussion when thinking but not outwardly verbalizing thoughts. It helps nurses assess clients and situations and think critically about them before communicating verbally.
- **Interpersonal communication:** communication between two people. This form of communication is the most common in nursing and requires an exchange of information with another individual. However, messages the receiver receives can differ from what the sender intended.
- **Public communication:** communication to, within, or between large groups of people. Using this type of communication, many nurses teach, give community presentations, alright about nursing or health care topics and issues.
- **Small group communication:** communication within a group of people, working towards a mutual goal.

Underlying Principles

- Therapeutic communication is the purposeful use of communication to build and maintain helping relationship with clients families and significant others.
- Nurses use interactive and purposeful communication skills to:
 - ~ Elicit and attend to clients' thoughts, feelings, concerns I needs.
 - ~ Expressed empathy and genuine concern for clients' and families' issues.
 - ~ Obtain information and give feedback about clients' status.
 - ~ Intervene to promote functional behavior and effective interpersonal relationships.
 - ~ Evaluate clients progress towards desired goals and outcome.
 - Children and older adults often require specific age-appropriate techniques to enhance communication.
 - The use of the nursing process depends on therapeutic communication among the nurse, client, family, significant other and the interprofessional health care team.

Nursing Interventions

WHO? WHEN? WHY? HOW?

- Establish a trusting nurse-client relationship. clients feel more at ease during the implementation phase establishing open relationship.
- Provide empathetic responses and explanations by using observations, giving information, conveying hope, and using humor.
- Manipulate the environment to decrease distractions.
- Make sure verbal communication and nonverbal communication are congruent, demonstrate an empathetic presence by appearing relaxed and comfortable, facing the client, having an open posture, leaning towards the client, and maintaining good eye contact, unless cultural norms discourage it.
