Conceptual Foundations for Multidisciplinary Thinking Stephen Jay Kline, 1995-01-01 Our current intellectual system provides us with a far more complete and accurate understanding of nature and ourselves than was available in any previous society This gain in understanding has arisen from two sources the use of the scientific method and the breaking up of our intellectual enterprise into increasingly narrower disciplines and research programs However we have failed to keep these narrow specialities connected to the intellectual enterprise as a whole The author demonstrates that this causes a number of difficulties We have no viewpoint from which we can understand the relationships between the disciplines and lack a forum for adjudicating situations where different disciplines give conflicting answers to the same problem We seriously underestimate the differences in methodology and in the nature of principles in the various branches of science This provocative and wide ranging book provides a detailed analysis and possible solutions for dealing with this problem

Academic Writing and Interdisciplinarity Ranamukalage Chandrasoma, 2010-09-13 Applied linguistics as a discipline embodies a wide canvass of knowledge pertaining to language studies. One dimension of this knowledge that has whetted the appetite of scholars is student academic writing. Professor Chandrasoma's book critically explores academic interdisciplinarity, a relatively new area of student writing in our contemporary contexts from different perspectives: approaches to ESL/EFL/EAP, disciplinary integration, linguistic capital, pedagogical practices in applied linguistics, generically diverse assessment tasks, extra-disciplinary pedagogic desire, curricular issues, and socio-economic imperatives. set of instrument driven scientific fields on their way towards science related technologies Even though nanotechnology patents contain more patent citations to the scientific literature than other technical fields the science and technology systems are relatively autonomous What links them in the case of nano science and technology is a common interest in improving techniques of nano scale measurement and manipulation Another finding is that both countries and firms exhibit relatively strong path dependencies While nanotechnology comprises a key set of technological areas instrumentation electronics and pharmaceuticals chemicals nano scale activities vary considerably from country to country Also knowledge building activities of firms follow a strong technological path dependency As a result social capital seems to be confined to chiefly technological or scientific trajectories Hence social capital appears not to be very useful in explaining how knowledge is accumulated and integrated at the nano scale Given the central role of instrumentation and the mediated nature of exchange between science and technology at the nano scale public policies should be directed towards supporting education and infrastructure in the area rather than more direct transfer mechanisms
