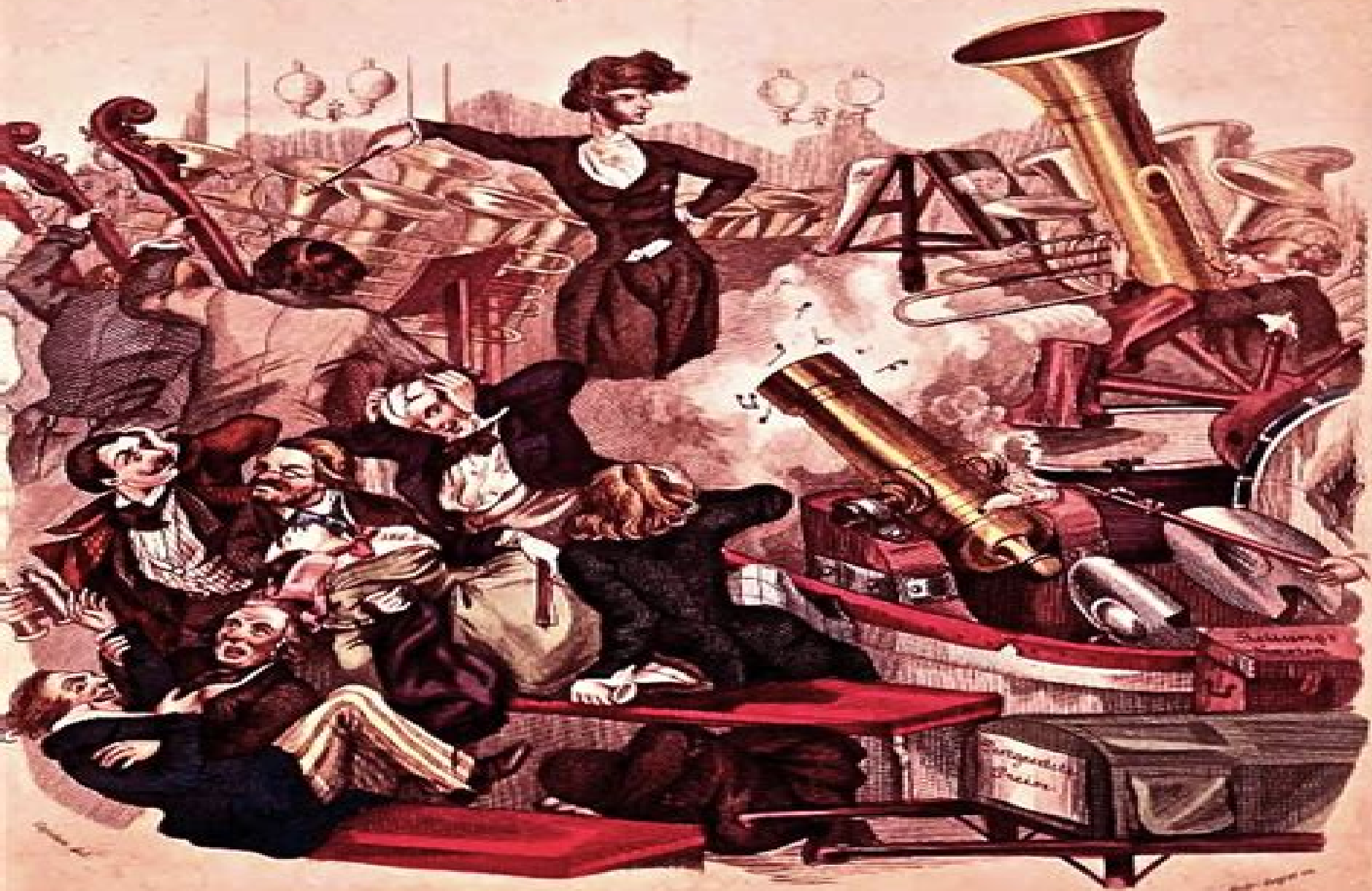


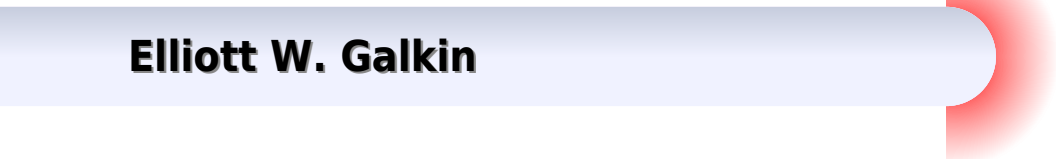

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A History of Orchestral Conducting Elliott W. Galkin, 1988 Although the bibliography of literature about personalities in the conducting world is extensive a comprehensive scholarly study of the history of conducting has been sorely lacking Georg Sch nemann's respected study published in 1913 was brief and restricted to the procedures of time beating No work has attempted to examine the role of the orchestral conductor and to document the evolution of his art from historical technical and aesthetic perspectives Dr Elliott W Galkin musicologist conductor and critic twice winner of the Deems Taylor award for distinguished writing about music has produced such a work in A History of Orchestral Conducting The central historical section of the book which examines chronologically the theories and functions of time beating and interpretative concepts of performance is preceded by discussions of rhythm development of the orchestral medium and the evolving characteristics of orchestration Conductors of unusual pivotal influence are examined in depth as is the increasingly complex psychology of the podium Critical writings since the time of Monteverdi and the birth of the orchestra are surveyed and compared Analyses of conducting as an art and craft by musicians from Berlioz to Bernstein and commentators from Mattheson Bernard Shaw and Thomas Mann to Jacques Barzun are described and discussed A fascinating collection of engravings wood cuts photographs and caricatures contributes to the richness of this work

The Cambridge Companion to Berlioz Peter Bloom, 2000-08-24 Still chiefly known as the extravagant composer of the Symphonie fantastique Berlioz was an artist caught

in the crossfire between the academic classicism of the French musical establishment and the romantic modernism of the Parisian musical scene He was a thinker in an age that invented both the religion of art and the notion of the genius who preached and practised it This Companion contains essays by eminent scholars on Berlioz's place in nineteenth century French cultural life on his principal compositions symphonies overtures operas sacred works songs on his major writings a delightful volume of memoirs a number of short stories large quantities of music criticism an orchestration treatise on his direct and indirect encounters with other famous musicians Gluck Mozart Beethoven Wagner and on his legacy in France The volume is framed by a detailed chronology of his life and a usefully annotated bibliography **Berlioz's Orchestration**

Treatise Berlioz, 2002-08-08 Berlioz's Orchestration Treatise is a classic textbook which has been used as a guide to orchestration and as a source book for the understanding both of Berlioz's music and of orchestral practice in the nineteenth century This was the first English translation of Berlioz's complete text since 1856 and it is accompanied throughout by Hugh Macdonald's extensive and authoritative commentary on the instruments of Berlioz's time and on his own orchestral practice as revealed in his scores It also includes extracts from Berlioz's writings on instruments in his Memoirs and in his many articles for the Parisian press The Treatise has been highly valued both for its technical information about instruments but also for its poetic and visionary approach to the art of instrumentation Berlioz was not only one of the great orchestrators of the nineteenth century he was also the author with the clearest understanding of the art The Life of Berlioz Peter Bloom, 1998-11-19 The Life of Berlioz situates the celebrated French musician in the vibrant and highly politicized musical culture of the periods of the Bourbon Restoration July Monarchy Second Republic and Second Empire in which he lived and worked as composer conductor concert manager and writer The author of the *Symphonie fantastique* was indeed possessed of a fertile and fantastical imagination but the common image of Berlioz as a misunderstood and mistreated genius obscures both the solidity of his work as a musical architect and the reality of his position as one sometimes favored by those in power Berlioz is the quintessential romantic composer by dint of the conspicuous intermingling of art and life that marks his musical and literary output Studying this away from the subjective sentimentality that can still mar studies of the composer in France serves only to enhance the uncommon radiance of his music and uncommon esprit of his art *Hector Berlioz*,

The Compleat Conductor Gunther Schuller,1998-12-10 A world renowned conductor and composer who has lead most of the major orchestras in North America and Europe a talented musician who has played under the batons of such luminaries as Toscanini and Walter and an esteemed arranger scholar author and educator Gunther Schuller is without doubt a major figure in the music world Now in The Compleat Conductor Schuller has penned a highly provocative critique of modern conducting one that is certain to stir controversy Indeed in these pages he castigates many of this century s most venerated conductors for using the podium to indulge their own interpretive idiosyncrasies rather than devote themselves to reproducing the composer s stated and often painstakingly detailed intentions Contrary to the average concert goer s notion all too often shared by the musicians as well that conducting is an easily learned skill Schuller argues here that conducting is the most demanding musically all embracing and complex task in the field of music performance Conducting demands profound musical sense agonizing hours of study and unbending integrity Most important a conductor s overriding concern must be to present a composer s work faithfully and accurately scrupulously following the score including especially dynamics and tempo markings with utmost respect and care Alas Schuller finds rare is the conductor who faithfully adheres to a composer s wishes To document this Schuller painstakingly compares hundreds of performances and recordings with the original scores of eight major compositions Beethoven s fifth and seventh symphonies Schumann s second last movement only Brahms s first and fourth Tchaikovsky s sixth Strauss s Till Eulenspiegel and Ravel s Daphnis et Chloe Second Suite Illustrating his points with numerous musical examples Schuller reveals exactly where conductors have done well and where they have mangled the composer s work As he does so he also illuminates the interpretive styles of many of our most celebrated conductors offering pithy observations that range from blistering criticism of Leonard Bernstein one of the world s most histrionic and exhibitionist conductors to effusive praise of Carlos Kleiber who is so unique so remarkable so outstanding that one can only describe him as a phenomenon Along the way he debunks many of the music world s most enduring myths such as the notion that most of Beethoven s metronome markings were wrong or unplayable or that Schumann was a poor orchestrator and takes on the cultish clan of period instrument performers observing that many of their claims are totally spurious and chimeric In his epilogue Schuller sets forth clear guidelines for conductors that he believes will help steer them away from self indulgence towards the correct realization of great art Courageous eloquent and brilliantly insightful The Compleat Conductor throws down the gauntlet to conductors worldwide It is a controversial book
