Built in 1818 by John Brockenbrough the mansion at Twelfth and Clay streets was home to some of Richmond's leading citizens. The building was thrust into prominence in 1861 when the city of Richmond purchased it to be used as the executive mansion for Jefferson Davis president of the Confederate States of America. For nearly four years the White House of the Confederacy was a political and social center as well as a family home. With the collapse of the Confederacy in April 1865 the building became headquarters for the United States army that occupied Richmond. In November 1870 the finance committee of the Richmond city council decided to auction the contents of the Davis Mansion and convert the building into a public school. Auctioneer Wellington Goddin's advertisement in the local newspapers boasted that the location and neighborhood are equal to the best in Richmond and by reason of its commanding eminence the view from it is most lovely. After twenty years as a school the building had lost most of its luster and the city council condemned it to destruction. Fortunately an organization of Richmond women lobbied successfully to save the structure and turned it into a museum for relics of the Confederacy. Saved as a shrine of the Confederate Lost Cause the mansion has in recent years been restored to the beauty and magnificence of its heyday the time when its occupant was Jefferson Davis. These handsome photographs chronicle the history of the White House of the Confederacy the people associated with it and the building's rebirth as a historic home of national significance.
