Thus an endeavour has been made to make this book up to date with recent methods. The first part of this book covers the classical volumetric as well as gravimetric methods of analysis. The separation methods are prerequisite for dependable quantitative methods of analysis. Therefore, not only solvent extraction separations but also chromatographic methods such as adsorption, partition, ion exchange, exclusion, and electrochromatography have been included to keep pace with modern developments. The newly discovered techniques such as ion chromatography, supercritical fluid chromatography, and capillary electrophoresis have been included. The next part of the book encompasses the well-known spectroscopic methods such as UV, visible, IR, NMR, and ESR techniques and also atomic absorption and plasma spectroscopy and molecular luminescence methods. Novel analytical techniques such as Auger ESCA and photoacoustic spectroscopy of surfaces are also included. The final part of this book covers thermal and radioanalytical methods of analysis. The concluding chapters on electroanalytical techniques include potentiometry, conductometry, coulometry, and voltammetry inclusive of all kinds of polarography. The theme of on-line analysis is covered in automated methods of analysis. To sustain the interest of the reader, each chapter is provided with latest references to the monographs in the field. Further to test the comprehension of the subject, each chapter is provided with a large number of solved and unsolved problems.
