 - ◉ Ex: graylag goose egg-rolling behavior
- ▣ Occur in unalterable (stereotyped) sequence
 - ◉ Minor alterations may occur
- ▣ Are not learned (are innate)
- ▣ Can be triggered inappropriately
 - ◉ Ex: stickleback response to unrealistic models, etc.
