which they believed had broken down they increasingly viewed the charity offered by religious houses as insufficient to meet the local needs In such a climate the Protestant social gospel seemed to provide a valid alternative to which many people gravitated Holding to scrutiny the revisionist revolution of the past twenty years the book reopens debate and challenges conventional thinking about the ways the traditional church lost influence in the late middle ages positing the idea that the problems with the religious houses were not just the creation of the reformers but had rather a long history In so doing it offers a more complete picture of reform that goes beyond head counting by looking at the political relationships and how they were affected by religious ideas to bring about change The Idol in the Age of Art Rebecca Zorach, 2017-07-05 After 1500 as Catholic Europe fragmented into warring sects evidence of a pagan past came newly into view and travelers to distant places encountered deeply unfamiliar visual cultures it became ever more pressing to distinguish between the sacred image and its opposite the idol Historians and philosophers have long attended to Reformation charges of idolatry the premise for image breaking but only very recently have scholars begun to consider the ways that the idol occasioned the making no less than the destruction The present book focuses on how idols and ideas about them matter for the history of early modern objects produced around the globe especially those created in the context of an exchange or confrontation between an us and a them Ranging widely within the early modern period the volume contributes to the project of globalizing the study of European art bringing the continent's commercial colonial antiquarian and religious histories into dialogue Its studies of crosses statues on columns wax ex votos ivories prints maps manuscripts fountains banners and New World gold all frame Western art simultaneously as an idea and as a collection of real things arguing that it was through the idol that object makers and writers came to terms with what it was that art should be and do **Catholic and Protestant** Translations of the Imitatio Christi, 1425-1650 Mr Maximilian von Habsburg, 2013-07-28 The Imitatio Christi is considered one of the classic texts of Western spirituality There were 800 manuscript copies and more than 740 different printed editions of the Imitatio between its composition in the fifteenth century and 1650 During the Reformation period the book retained its popularity with both Protestants and Catholics with the exception of the Bible it was the most frequently printed book of the sixteenth century In this pioneering study the remarkable longevity of the Imitatio across geographical chronological linguistic and confessional boundaries is explored Rather than attributing this enduring popularity to any particular quality of universality this study suggests that its key virtue was its appropriation by different interest groups That such an apparently Catholic and monastic work could be adopted and adapted by both Protestant reformers and Catholic activists including the Jesuits poses intriguing questions about our understanding of Reformation and Counter Reformation theology and confessional politics This study focuses on the editions of the Imitatio printed in English French German and Latin between the 1470s and 1650 It offers an ambitious and comprehensive survey of the process of translation and its impact and contribution to religious culture In so doing it offers a fresh analysis of spirituality and devotion within their

proper late medieval and early modern contexts It also demonstrates that spirituality was not a peripheral dimension of religion but remains at the very heart of both Catholic and Protestant self perception and identity Scottish Parish Dr John McCallum, 2013-06-28 The Protestant Reformation of 1560 is widely acknowledged as being a watershed moment in Scottish history However whilst the antecedents of the reform movement have been widely explored the actual process of establishing a reformed church in the parishes in the decades following 1560 has been largely ignored This book helps remedy the situation by examining the foundation of the reformed church and the impact of Protestant discipline in the parishes of Fife In early modern Scotland Fife was both a distinct and important region containing a preponderance of coastal burghs as well as St Andrews the ecclesiastical capital of medieval Scotland It also contained many rural and inland parishes making it an ideal case study for analysing the course of religious reform in diverse communities Nevertheless the focus is on the Reformation rather than on the county and the book consistently places Fife's experience in the wider Scottish British and European context Based on a wide range of under utilised sources especially kirk session minutes the study s focus is on the grass roots religious life of the parish rather than the more familiar themes of church politics and theology It evaluates the success of the reformers in affecting both institutional and ideological change and provides a detailed account of the workings of the reformed church and its impact on ordinary people In so doing it addresses important questions regarding the timescale and geographical patterns of reform and how such dramatic religious change succeeded and endured without violence or indeed widespread opposition Humanism and Protestantism in Early Modern English Education Professor Ian Green, 2013-06-28 This volume is the first attempt to assess the impact of both humanism and Protestantism on the education offered to a wide range of adolescents in the hundreds of grammar schools operating in England between the Reformation and the Enlightenment By placing that education in the context of Lutheran Calvinist and Jesuit education abroad it offers an overview of the uses to which Latin and Greek were put in English schools and identifies the strategies devised by clergy and laity in England for coping with the tensions between classical studies and Protestant doctrine It also offers a reassessment of the role of the godly in English education and demonstrates the many ways in which a classical education came to be combined with close support for the English Crown and established church One of the major sources used is the school textbooks which were incorporated into the English Stock set up by leading members of the Stationers Company of London and reproduced in hundreds of thousands of copies during the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries Although the core of classical education remained essentially the same for two centuries there was a growing gulf between the methods by which classics were taught in elite institutions such as Winchester and Westminster and in the many town and country grammar schools in which translations or bilingual versions of many classical texts were given to weaker students The success of these new translations probably encouraged editors and publishers to offer those adults who had received little or no classical education new versions of works by Aesop Cicero Ovid Virgil Seneca and Caesar

The Dutch translations are presented as a case study of an ultra protestant and anti-Spanish reading from which James emerges as a potential leader of protestant Europe a reputation he initially courted then distanced himself from after his accession to the English throne in 1603 In so doing this book greatly adds to our appreciation of James as an author providing an exploration of his works as politically expedient statements which were sometimes ambiguous enough to allow diverging and occasionally unwelcome interpretations It is one of the few studies of James to offer a sustained critical reading of these texts together with an exploration of the national and international context in which they were published and read As such this book contributes to the understanding not only of James s works as political tools but also of the preoccupations of publishers and translators and the interpretative spaces in the works they were making available to an international audience **Baal's Priests** Ms Fiona McCall,2013-05-28 The English Civil War was a time of disruption suffering and persecution for many people not least the clergy of the established church who found themselves ejected from their livings in increasing numbers as Parliamentarian forces extended their control across the
