The book takes the view the tense agreement dissociation reported for Hebrew Friedmann and Grodzinsky 1997 and German Wenzlaff and Clahsen 2003 can be replicated in Moroccan Arabic However the syntactic account as outlined in Friedmann and Grodzinsky 1997 cannot account for the tense agreement dissociation as Moroccan Arabic has the agreement node above the tense node In addition the Trace Deletion Hypothesis cannot account for the comprehension difficulties experienced by the four Moroccan Arabic speaking agrammatic subjects the case is so because both subject relatives and object relatives are understood below chance level Based on data collected through different experimental methods it is argued that the deficit in agrammatism cannot be explained in terms of a structural account but rather in terms of a processing account Access to syntactic knowledge tends to be blocked grammatical knowledge however is entirely intact Aspects of Multilingual Aphasia Martin R.
