Majority Voting: When It Works

majority voting The typical mechanism used to aggregate individual votes into a social decision, whereby individual policy options are put to a vote and the option that receives the majority of votes is chosen.

To be consistent, the aggregation mechanism must satisfy three goals:

- ▶ *Dominance.*
- ▶ *Transitivity.*
- ▶ *Independence of irrelevant alternatives.*

Majority voting can *produce a consistent aggregation of individual preferences only if preferences are restricted to take a certain form.*

originates from about seven years ago when we became involved in research in the field of applied microeconomics To our astonishment a vast majority of researchers in this area took it for granted that their mostly thoroughly derived micro models could meaningfully be confronted with per capita data Many of them did not even realize at least they gave no utterance to it that applying macro data in micro models raises considerable problems Those who did mention the difficulty almost always belittled its importance Fortunately there are noteworthy exceptions Thinking about aggregation raises at least two questions Why or why not aggregate and How to aggregate and in particular to what degree General answers to these questions can only be given in uninformative wording as many assertions in economics one aggregates for the sake of tractability because of the lack of individual data to avoid or to reduce multicollinearity to save degrees of freedom one abstains from aggregation to avoid loss of information to avoid aggregation biases and one aggregates such and to such degree as to bypass or reduce the drawbacks mentioned above

Cole,Mei-Ling Ting Lee,2013-06-29 On October 16 and 17 2000 we hosted an international workshop entitled Statistical Design Measurement and Analysis of Health Related Quality of Life The workshop was held in the beautiful city of Arradon South Brittany France with the main goal of fostering an interdisciplinary forum for discussion of theoretical and applied statistical issues arising in studies of health related quality of life HRQoL Included were biostatisticians psychometricians

and public health professionals e.g. physicians, sociologists, psychologists active in the study of HRQoL. In assembling this volume we invited each conference participant to contribute a paper based on his or her presentation and the ensuing and very interesting discussions that took place in Arradon. All papers were peer reviewed by anonymous reviewers and revised before final editing and acceptance. Although this process was quite time consuming we believe that it greatly improved the volume as a whole making this book a valuable contribution to the field of HRQoL research. - Social Choice Theory* Satish Kumar Jain, 2022-11-01. have largely been in the direction of reaffirming the limits of the market and of establishing new ones. The possible existence of fundamental non convexities, imperfect and asymmetric information, incentive compatibility, imperfect competition, strategic complementarity and scale economies led to the conclusion that a large set of market failures exist; such situations also imply government failure. Acocella considers this complicated picture and provides a discussion of the different approaches to establishing social rankings of the possible situations and the underlying principles. The arguments for and against different institutions are then analysed at a micro and macroeconomic level. The market and the government are recognised as imperfect and thus complementary institutions. Specific policy targets and instruments are considered in the areas of micro and macro economic policy. Special attention is devoted to questions of policy management in an open economy. Finally, problems of domestic and international policy co ordination are considered.
