Cuts Carl Andre, 2021-08-03 Statements dialogue letters epigrams and poems by sculptor Carl Andre a central figure in minimalism Just as Carl Andre's sculptures are cuts of elemental materials his writings are condensed expressions cuts of language that emphasize the part rather than the whole Andre a central figure in minimalism and one of the most influential sculptors of our time does not produce the usual critical essay He has said that he is not a writer of prose and the texts included in *Cuts* the most comprehensive collection of his writings yet published appear in a wide variety of forms that are pithy and poetic rather than prosaic Some texts are statements many of them fifty words or less written for catalog entries and press releases Others are Socratic dialogues interwoven statements or in the form of questionnaires and interviews Still others are letters public and private lengthy missives and postcards Some are epigrams and maxims for example on Damien Hirst I DON'T FEAR HIS SHARK I FEAR HIS FORMALDEHYDE and some are planar poems words and letters arranged and rearranged into different patterns They are organized alphabetically by subject under such entries as Art and Capitalism Childhood Entropy After Smithsonian Matter My Work Other Artists and Poetry and they include Andre's reflections on Michelangelo and Duchamp on Stein and Marx and such contemporaries as Eva Hesse Robert Rauschenberg Robert Morris and Damien Hirst Carl Andre's writing and its materiality its stress on the visual and tactile qualities of language takes its place beside his sculpture and its materiality its revelation of matter as matter rather than matter as symbol Both assert the ethical and political primacy of matter in a culture that prizes the replica the insubstantial and the virtual I am not an idealist as an artist says Andre I try to discover my visions in the conditions of the world It's the conditions which are important *Carl Andre - Cuts. Texts 1959-2004* Carl Andre, James Meyer, 2005 *absence of clutter* Paul Stephens, 2020-03-24 An exploration of minimal writing texts generally shorter than a sentence as complex powerful literary and visual works In the 1960s and 70s minimal and conceptual artists stripped language down to its most basic components the word and the letter Barbara Kruger Jenny Holzer Carl Andre Lawrence Weiner and others built lucrative careers from text based art Meanwhile poets and writers created works of minimal writing visual texts generally shorter than a sentence One poem by Aram Saroyan reads in its entirety eyeeye In absence of clutter Paul Stephens offers the first comprehensive account of minimal writing arguing that it is equal in complexity and power to better known more commercial text based art Minimal writing Stephens writes can be beguilingly simple on the surface but can also offer iterative reading experiences on multiple levels from the fleeting to the ponderous absence of clutter for example the entire text of a poem by Robert Grenier is both expressive and self descriptive Stephens first sets out a theoretical framework for reading and viewing minimal writing and then offers close readings of works of minimal writing by Saroyan Grenier Norman Pritchard Natalie Czech and others He reverse engineers recent works by Jen Bervin Craig Dworkin and Christian Bök that draw on molecular biology and explores print on demand books by Holly Melgard code poetry by Nick Montfort Twitter based work by Allison Parrish and the use of Instagram by Hans Ulrich Obrist

and Saroyan Text it seems is becoming ever more prevalent in visual art meanwhile poems are getting shorter When reading has become scanning a screen and writing tapping out a text absence of clutter invites us to reflect on how we read see and pay attention *Installation art as experience of self, in space and time* Christine Vial Kayser, Sylvie Coëllier, 2021-09-07
