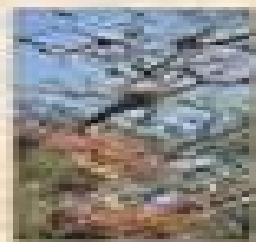

the credit gap could prove useful to enhance the resilience of the region's financial sector but the activation of macroprudential instruments should also be informed by the development of other macrofinancial variables and by expert judgment

Spillovers to Central America in Light of the Crisis Mr. Andrew Swiston, 2010-02-01 This paper investigates Central America's external linkages over the last fifteen years of increased integration in light of the 2008-09 global recession Using structural VAR models it is found that a one percent shock to U.S. growth shifts economic activity in Central America by 0.7 to 1 percent on average Spillovers from global shocks and the rest of the region also affect activity in some countries Spillovers are mostly transmitted through advanced country financial conditions and fluctuations in external demand for Central American exports Shocks to advanced economies associated with the 2008-09 financial crisis lowered economic activity in the region by 4 to 5 percent on average accounting for a majority of the observed slowdown The impact was almost twice as large as elasticities estimated on pre-crisis data would have predicted These results underscore the importance of operating credible policy frameworks that enable a countercyclical policy response to external shocks
