The notion of Continuation in medieval literature is a familiar one but difficult to define precisely. Despite the existence of important texts which are commonly referred to as Continuations such as *Le Roman de la Rose* *Le Chevalier de la Charrette* and of course the *Perceval* Continuations, the mechanics and processes involved in actually producing a Continuation have found themselves indistinguishable from those associated with other forms of medieval literature. The *Perceval* Continuations composed c. 1200-1230 constitute a vast body of material which incorporates four separately authored Continuations, each of which seeks to further in some way the unfinished *Perceval* of Chrétien de Troyes, though they are not merely responses to his work.
