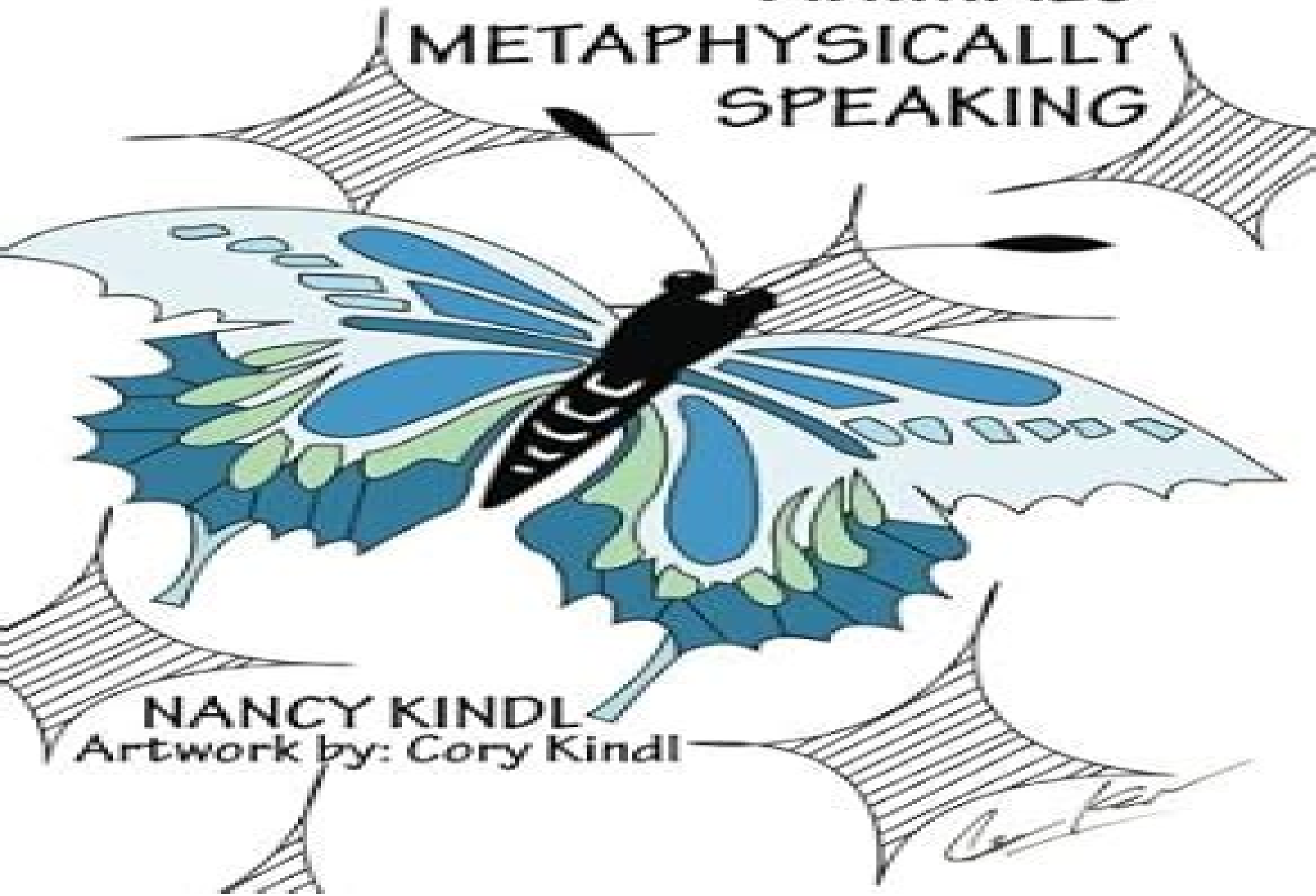

Fay Edwards, 2018 Philosophical controversy over non human animals extends further back than many realize before Utilitarianism and Darwinism to the very genesis of philosophy This volume examines the richness and complexity of that long history Twelve essays trace the significance of animals from Greek and Indian antiquity through the Islamic and Latin medieval traditions to Renaissance and early modern thought ending with contemporary notions about animals Two main questions emerge throughout the volume what capacities can be ascribed to animals and how should we treat them Notoriously ungenerous attitudes towards animals mental lives and ethics status found for instance in Aristotle and Descartes are shown to have been more nuanced than often supposed while remarkable defenses of benevolence towards animals are unearthed in late antiquity India the Islamic world and Kant Other chapters examine cannibalism and vegetarianism in Renaissance thought and the scientific testing of animals A series of interdisciplinary reflections sheds further light on human attitudes towards animals looking at their depiction in visual artworks from China Africa and Europe as well as the rich tradition of animal fables beginning with Aesop

contemporary Radical Orthodoxy readings that have Aquinas forfeit demonstrative proof that God exists misconstrue him on this point

The Political Animal in Medieval Philosophy Juhana Toivanen, 2020-10-12 In *The Political Animal in Medieval Philosophy* Juhana Toivanen investigates what medieval philosophers meant when they argued that human beings are political animals by nature. He analyses the notion of political animal from various perspectives and shows its relevance to philosophical discussions concerning the foundations of human sociability, ethics and politics. Medieval authors believed that social life stems from the biological and rational nature of human beings and that collaboration with other people promotes prosperity and good life. Toivanen provides a detailed philosophical interpretation of this view across a wide range of authors, including unedited manuscript sources. As the first monograph-length study on the topic, *The Political Animal* sheds new light on this significant period in western political thought.

Mindreading Animals Robert W. Lurz, 2011-07-29 A comprehensive examination of a hotly debated question proposes a new model for mindreading in animals and a new experimental approach. Animals live in a world of other minds, human and nonhuman, and their well-being and survival often depends on what is going on in the minds of these other creatures. But do animals know that other creatures have minds? And how would we know if they do? In *Mindreading Animals*, Robert Lurz offers a fresh approach to the hotly debated question of mental state attribution in nonhuman animals. Some empirical researchers and philosophers claim that some animals are capable of anticipating other creatures' behaviors by interpreting observable cues as signs of underlying mental states; others claim that animals are merely clever behavior readers capable of using such cues to anticipate others' behaviors without interpreting them as evidence of underlying mental states. Lurz argues that neither position is compelling and proposes a way to move the debate and the field forward. Lurz offers a bottom-up model of mental state attribution that is built on cognitive abilities that animals are known to possess rather than on a preconceived view of the mind applicable to mindreading abilities in humans. Lurz goes on to describe an innovative series of new experimental protocols for animal mindreading research that show in detail how various types of animals, from apes to monkeys to ravens to dogs, can be tested for perceptual state and belief attribution.
