Industrial Development and Policy in Africa Hossein Jalilian, Michael A. Tribe, John Weiss, 2000 This book surveys the current state of industry in sub Saharan Africa and examines claims that Africa is de industrialising It focuses on the challenge for economic policy to find ways to reverse this trend The contributors begin by analysing general issues relating to industrialisation in Africa including the question of Africa's comparative advantage in industry the role of small scale enterprises and the scope for infant industry promotion They then focus on issues such as evidence of de industrialisation

within Africa comparative industrial performance between African countries and economies outside Africa the role of regional trade integration lessons to be learnt from industrialisation in East Asia policies of major lending institutions towards industrial loans The authors then consider evidence from country studies including export performance in Nigeria protection and transport costs in Uganda public enterprises in Tanzania enterprise reform in South Africa and the impact of free trade policies in Southern Africa They find that the diversity of experience in the region and the complexity of the issues caution against accepting simple generalisations on African industrialisation Industrial Development and Policy in Africa will be required reading for scholars of economic development and industrial economics **IMF - World Bank and Labor's**

Burdens in Africa Kwamina Panford, 2001-08-30 Globalization the return to a multi party system of government and the policies advocated by the IMF and the World Bank have led to near revolutionary labor relations in Ghana As Panford shows these new social and economic forces have unleashed new and even contradictory labor policies and practices which are having profound social political and economic consequences Panford examines how the Ghana Constitution of 1992 led for the first time to new workers rights including the right to affiliate with any local national or international union In response to globalization and policies advocated by the IMF and the World Bank the Ghana government sought to resist worker demands for improved working and living conditions The situation was worsened by the privatization of state owned businesses and severe cuts in public employment In this environment of tense labor relations government hostility and weak employment Panford traces the ways workers are revitalizing unions and developing new sources of jobs and finances These include relatively aggressive systematic organization of women senior staff and the informal agricultural sector One of the most important initiatives of the unions is the creation of a workers trust to establish and finance worker owned enterprises The evidence presented by Panford indicates the failure of IMF and World Bank policies and he calls for new and viable policy alternatives with emphasis on enhancing Ghana's global competitiveness and meeting genuine development needs A thoughtful analysis that will be of interest to scholars and researchers involved with development and international economics labor relations in the developing world and the increased involvement of international financial institutions

Privatizing Health Services in Africa Meredith Turshen, 1999 Privatizing Health Services in Africa analyzes the disappearance of public health in the form of state services in Africa and the growth of a private market in health care that will serve primarily an urban elite Meredith Turshen considers the implications of introducing private insurance in countries with growing unemployment a shrinking formal job sector and a lack of social security programs or other safety nets She debates the pros and cons of shifting the delivery of health services to the nongovernmental sector in the context of new concepts of the role of the state Many of the schemes to privatize the purchase and sale of pharmaceuticals reverse decades of United Nations work challenging the power of the multinational drug industry Turshen weighs these policy changes in light of the World Bank's eclipse of the World Health Organization as the premier UN health policy agency Until now no book

has disputed the World Bank's plans to privatize health care in Africa. This is the first book-length analysis of policy changes in light of monetarism and globalization. Throughout the book, Turshen examines the implications of privatization for gender equity. She also provides a case study of Zimbabwe and comparative material from Malawi, Mozambique, and Zambia. Her study makes a contribution to current debates on the impact of structural adjustment policies on health and the design of health services in the Third World.

Intellectual Property, Biogenetic Resources and Traditional Knowledge Graham Dutfield, 2010-09-23. Biogenetic resources—the critical biological and chemical materials that underpin so much of medicine, both modern and traditional agriculture, and wider economic activity in so many fields—are at the centre of heated debate regarding their use, development, and ownership, and the issues of ethics and equity that impinge on all of these factors. Part 3 focuses on traditional knowledge, its nature, its importance, and the applicability of IPR-style protection. Part 4 covers the international negotiation and policy making of the WTO, WIPO, and CBD, and the legislative initiatives of national governments of Asia, Africa, and Latin America. Finally, Part 5 focuses on two developing country case studies of India and Kenya, assessing whether they will be able to gain economic benefit from development of their natural resources within the current regulatory system and whether this will encourage the conservation and sustainable use of the resource base. With its multidisciplinary approach and breadth of coverage, this book will appeal both to those new to the subject and to those with professional and specialist interest, including students, academics, legal practitioners, government policy makers, and the private sector.
