

on specific mathematics topics Several themes emerge from the volume One is that while the rate of improvement in mathematics learning in grades 4 and 8 has slowed in recent years it has slowed more on some topics than others Another is that relatively minor changes in wording can have significant effects on student performance and thus it is difficult to be specific about what students can do without knowing exactly what questions they were asked A third theme is that changes in performance over time can sometimes but not always be understood in terms of what students are taught For example there were substantial gains on several grade 4 items requiring understanding of fractions and that is probably because the amount of instruction on fractions in grades 3 and 4 has been increasing In contrast while relatively few twelfth grade students have ever been good at factoring trinomials performance on this skill seems to be decreasing This suggests that while more students are completing advanced mathematics courses in high school these courses are not helping in the area of factoring trinomials Finally there are limitations to using NAEP as a measure of student performance on the Common Core State Standards To the extent that NAEP can be used however the NAEP data show a substantial gap between expectations Applying the Rasch Model Trevor G.
