Consumable Metaphors Ceri Crossley, 2005 This book studies the various definitions of animal nature proposed by nineteenth century currents of thought in France It is based on an examination of a number of key thinkers and writers some well known for example Michelet and Lamartine others largely forgotten for example Gleizes and Reynaud At the centre of the book lies the idea that knowledge of animals is often knowledge of something else that the primary referentiality is overlaid with additional levels of meaning In nineteenth century France thinking about animals their future and their past became a way of thinking about power relations in society for example about the status of women and the problem of the labouring classes This book analyses how animals as symbols externalize and mythologize human fears and wishes but it also demonstrates that animals have an existence in and for themselves and are not simply useful counters functioning within discourse

Gendered Violence in Biblical Narrative Esther Brownsmith, 2024-04-15 This book uses three examples of violent biblical stories about women explored through the lens of conceptual metaphor theory in relation to culinary language used within these texts to examine wider issues of gender and sexual violence in the Hebrew Bible Utilising the tools of conceptual metaphor theory feminist criticism and classic textual analysis Brownsmith interrogates some of the most troubling biblical passages for women neither by redeeming them nor by condemning them but by showing how they are intrinsically shaped by the enduring metaphor of woman as food in the Hebrew Bible ancient Near East and beyond The volume explores three main case studies the Levite's concubine Judges 19 Tamar and Amnon 2 Sam 13 and the life and death of Jezebel primarily 1 Kings 21 and 2 Kings 9 All depict violence toward a woman as perpetrated by a man interwoven with culinary language that cues their metaphorical implications In these sensitive but critical readings of violent tales Brownsmith also draws on a broad range of interdisciplinary connections from Ricoeur to ancient Ugaritic epics to modern comic books Through this approach readers gain new insights into how the Bible shapes its narratives through conceptual metaphors and specifically how it makes meaning out of women's brutalized bodies **Gendered Violence in Biblical Narrative** The Devouring Metaphor is suitable for students and scholars working on gender and sexual violence in the Hebrew Bible and the ancient Near East more broadly as well as those working on conceptual metaphor theory and feminist criticism

A Taste for Purity Julia Hauser, 2023-12-05 In nineteenth century Europe and North America an organized vegetarian movement began warning of the health risks and ethical problems of meat eating Presenting a vegetarian diet as a cure for the social ills brought on by industrialization and urbanization this movement idealized South Asia as a model In colonial India where diets were far more varied than Western admirers realized new motives for avoiding meat also took hold Hindu nationalists claimed that vegetarianism would cleanse the body for anticolonial resistance and an increasingly militant cow protection movement mobilized against meat eaters particularly Muslims Unearthing the connections among these developments and many others Julia Hauser explores the global history of vegetarianism from the mid nineteenth century to the early Cold War She traces personal networks and exchanges of knowledge spanning Europe the United States and South Asia highlighting mutual influence as well as the disconnects of cross cultural encounters Hauser argues that vegetarianism in this period was motivated by expansive visions

of moral physical and even racial purification Adherents were convinced that society could be changed by transforming the body of the individual Hauser demonstrates that vegetarians in India and the West shared notions of purity which drew some toward not only internationalism and anticolonialism but also racism nationalism and violence Finding preoccupations with race and masculinity as well as links to colonialism and eugenics she reveals the implication of vegetarian movements in exclusionary hierarchical projects Deeply researched and compellingly argued *A Taste for Purity* rewrites the history of vegetarianism on a global scale

The Novels of Madame de Souza in Social and Political Perspective Kirsty Carpenter, 2007 Madame de Souza's seven major novels written in the period from 1794 to 1822 show the emergence of the female authored French novel and the novel's role as a vehicle for political ideas during the revolutionary period The novels *Ad le de S nange* *Emilie et Alphonse* *Charles et Marie Eug nie et Mathilde* *Eug ne de Rothelin* *Mademoiselle de Tournon* and *La comtesse de Fargy* make an important contribution to early nineteenth century French literature Madame de Souza was an acute observer of the intimate workings of Paris society and of social and political change in the years 1789-1830 Unedited extracts from her novels *Etre et Para tre* and other less complete manuscripts appear here in print for the first time The author was born in 1761 and lived through the political regimes of a Revolution Empire and Restoration dying in Paris in 1836 She had a long life filled with friends correspondents and travels in Britain and Europe and she was admired by literary critics like Sismondi and Marie Joseph Ch nier Until now a small amount of research has been focused on her first novel *Ad le de S nange* but this book shows that this is only one of seven works that should be better known than they are at present

artists critics and readers alike Gautier was the essential figure in French art journalism in the mid nineteenth century During the short lived but pivotal period of the Second Republic when the new administration was committed to reforming all the institutions of the fine arts Gautier deployed the full resources of his brilliant flexible and authoritative writing to support and direct these developments in ways compatible with his commitment to an idealist aesthetic itself under growing pressure from alternative trends in an increasingly competitive art market This first study of all Gautiers art journalism written during the Second Republic provides a long overdue reassessment of Gautiers importance in French nineteenth century visual culture

Euro-orientalism Ezequiel Adamovsky,2006 Drawing from a range of critical perspectives in particular postcolonial this book examines the relationship between perceptions of Russia and of Eastern Europe and the making of a Western identity It explores the ways in which the perception of certain characteristics of Russia and Eastern Europe whether real or attributed was shaped by and used for the construction of a liberal narrative of the West which eventually became dominant The focus of this inquiry is French culture from the beginning of the debate about Russia among the philosophes c 1740 to the consolidation of a professional field of Slavic studies c 1880 A wide range of writing literature travel accounts histories political tracts scientific journals and parliamentary debates is examined through the work of major authors from Montesquieu Diderot and Rousseau to Tocqueville de Maistre and Guizot from Mme de Sta l Hugo and Balzac to Dumas Michelet and Comte as well as that of many less well known figures The book also explores possible continuities between those first academic accounts of Russia and Eastern Europe and present day scholarship in Europe and the USA to show that the liberal ideological accounts constructed in the nineteenth century still to a great extent inform contemporary academic studies

Preserving the Provinces Andrew Watts,2007 Though famed for his vivid depictions of nineteenth century Paris Honor de Balzac devoted as much of his creative energy to the provinces This book examines the way in which he combined a theatrical tradition of anti provincial satire with a more open celebration of French provincial life in the post Revolutionary period Ranging widely over texts from both within and outside *La Com die humaine* the author analyses Balzac s determination to invest the Rousseauist nostalgia for country over city with an updated rationale A champion of central authority and absolutist government Balzac is seen here in an unfamiliar role as the guardian of regional culture a novelist who sought to record the diversity of France s small towns and villages before they were lost to industrialization and the railway age Equally the study reveals new aspects of his political engagement with questions impacting upon the provinces during the Restoration and July Monarchy from broad issues such as agriculture and landownership to more isolated grievances such as the implications of the 1827 Forest Code The whole offers a fresh insight into Balzac s thought and literary aesthetic and an assessment of his hitherto neglected role in supporting the emergence of the regionalist novel or roman du terroir in the second half of the nineteenth century

typhoid and rabies alongside phobias of animalism criminality hysteria impotency and ecological disaster each chapter makes an original contribution to this new field of scholarship By locating these discourses and visual cultures within the golden age of Neo Lamarckism they also reveal how regeneration was pictured as the Janus face of degeneration able to facilitate evolution through the inheritance of beneficial characteristics in propitious environments In striking such an uplifting note amidst the dissonant cacophony of catastrophism this book reveals why the art and science of Transformism proved so appealing in France as elsewhere and why visual cultures of regeneration became as dominant in the twentieth century as the picturing of degeneration had been in the nineteenth century It also illuminates the paradoxical inversion that occurred in the twentieth century when devolution became equivalent to evolution for many Modernists Hence whilst this book opens with the picturing of indigenous people in Australia and North America as doomed races by the first publication of Darwin's *On The Origin of Species* it closes with the quest by 1930 for a regenerative suntan as dark as the skin of those indigenous people
