Confession Leo Tolstoy, 2024-05-09 Leo Tolstoy s concise spiritual memoir *Confession* printed anonymously in Geneva in 1884 lays bare the existential abyss that opened beneath the author in mid life Those pages raw and unadorned reveal the turning point that fed every moral argument he later waged against empire church and himself Written between 1879 and 1882 but smuggled out of Russia to evade censorship the small volume appeared in a pamphlet edition from the Swiss press Posselt in 1884 at the very moment Tsarist authorities were forbidding public mention of the novelist s religious opinions its unobtrusive type and grey wrapper belie a tract that Russian readers would only legally see after the 1905 reforms yet its argument travelled by clandestine copy across intellectual circles from Moscow to London Within sixty pages Tolstoy narrates the collapse of inherited Orthodox faith the futility he discerned in literary fame and the suicidal despair that followed before recounting how the simple faith practised by muzhiks cutting hay persuaded him that life draws worth from service to others the prose moves with desperate lucidity merging autobiographical detail and Socratic dialectics in a texture closer to philosophical confession than to narrative The tract s influence upon Russian religious dissent on thinkers like Berdyaev and on later existential writing in Europe rivals that of Augustine s *Confessions* yet its style remains distinctly nineteenth century Russian plain vigorous occasionally sarcastic so that readers today can still hear a man arguing for his soul while the machinery of empire rattles in the background This critical reader s edition presents a modern translation of the original manuscript crafted for the modern reader with clean contemporary language and simplified sentence structures that clarify his complex Russian phrasing and specific antiquated references Supplementary material enriches the text with

autobiographical historical and linguistic context including an afterword by the translator on Tolstoy's personal history impact and intellectual legacy an index of the philosophical concepts he employs emphasizing Existentialism and influence by Schopenhauer a comprehensive chronological list of his published writings and a detailed timeline of his life highlighting the personal relationships that shaped his philosophy

Mind, Values, and Metaphysics Anne Reboul, 2014-08-06 There are three themed parts to this book values ethics and emotions in the first part epistemology perception and consciousness in the second part and philosophy of mind and philosophy of language in the third part Papers in this volume provide links between emotions and values and explore dependency between language meanings and concepts and topics such as the liar's paradox reference and metaphor are examined This book is the second of a two volume set that originates in papers presented to Professor Kevin Mulligan covering the subjects that he contributed to during his career This volume opens with a paper by Moya who proposes that there is an asymmetrical relation between the possibility of choice and moral responsibility The first part of this volume ends with a description of foolishness as insensitivity to the values of knowledge by Engel Marconi's article makes three negative claims about relative truth and Sundholm notes shortcomings of the English language for epistemology amongst other papers This section ends with a discussion of the term subjective character by Nida R melin who finds it misleading The third part of this volume contains papers exploring topics such as the mind body problem whether theory of mind is based on simulation or theory and K nne shows that the most common analyses of the so called Liar paradox are wanting At the end of this section Rizzi introduces syntactic cartography and illustrates its use in scope discourse semantics This second volume contains twenty nine chapters written by both high profile and upcoming researchers from across Europe North America and North Africa The first volume of this set has two main themes metaphysics especially truth making and the notion of explanation and the second theme is the history of philosophy with an emphasis on Austrian philosophy

Parliament,1948 *Anonymous Skeptics* Lance Ashdown,2002 At its deepest philosophical skepticism questions the sense of language Skepticism manifests itself in different forms three of the most powerful being logical external world and religious skepticism How has philosophy of religion addressed these challenges The attempt to answer this question leads Lance Ashdown to a consideration of three prominent contemporary philosophers of religion Richard Swinburne John Hick and William Alston The author shows that these philosophers are indeed open to the criticisms of the three types of skepticism mentioned above According to Ashdown they are rightly to be considered as anonymous skeptics Readers familiar with the work of the theologian Karl Rahner will recognize an echo of his famous doctrine that non Christian religious believers are really anonymous Christians i e Christian believers who do not recognize themselves as such In a similar way the philosophers of religion under consideration are skeptics who most certainly would not identify themselves as such They are anonymous skeptics in the sense that their epistemologies create the very conditions that allow for the severe and on their own terms unanswerable challenges of skepticism At the same time none of these philosophers thinks that skeptical objections pose a devastating or unanswerable threat to their epistemologies For example each of them is an avowed believer in God and is fully aware of the challenge of religious skepticism yet none believes that skepticism need cause a rational Christian to abandon his or her beliefs Nevertheless each of the three philosophers adheres to a philosophical theory that remains open to the devastating critique of Philo in David Hume s essay Dialogue Concerning Natural Religion who argues at his deepest that talk of God is meaningless

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
