authors pathologists orthopedic surgeons and radiologists felt the necessity of updating their works in recent years However in these publications different criteria of classification were adopted The number of cases compiled at the Latin American Registry of Bone Pathology increased from 4913 primary bone tumors and more than 1100 tumorlike lesions at the time of publication of the first edition of this book to 5274 bone tumors and 1665 tumorlike lesions by the end of December 1985 when I finished my work as head of the Registry and occupied the positions of Professor of Orthopedic Pathology at St Louis University Medical Center and Distinguished Visiting Professor at Rush Presbyterian St Luke s Medical Center in Chicago
