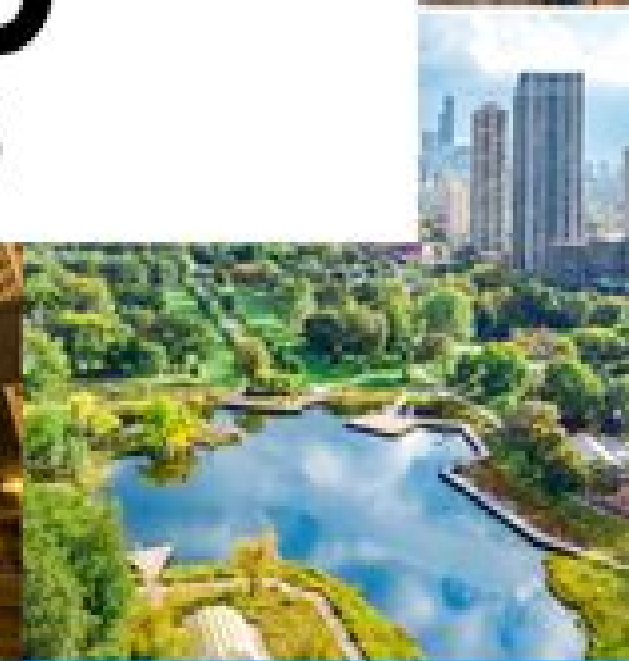

Shulman, MD,2014 In 1886 the state of the art surgery room of Truman W Miller MD in Chicago s first children s hospital had no electric lights no antibiotics limited equipment and only the most rudimentary anesthesia This renowned surgeon served on a voluntary basis as president of an all volunteer medical staff from 1882 to 1900 The hospital opened in 1882 as an eight bed cottage in Lincoln Park when pediatrics was in its infancy It was at the forefront then and it continues to be among the country s best For over a century it was called Children s Memorial Hospital and it was renamed Ann Robert H Lurie Children s Hospital of Chicago in 2012 when it moved to a 288 bed facility in the heart of the city The hospital s history reflects the steady advances in pediatrics propelled by visionary individuals pioneering clinicians and the community all dedicated to the care and well being of children
