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American Exceptionalism and the Remains of Race Edmund Fong,2014-07-11 In contemporary American political culture claims of American exceptionalism and anxieties over its prospects have resurged as an overarching theme in national political discourse Yet never very far from such debates lie animating fears associated with race Fears about the loss of national unity and trust often draw attention to looming changes in the racial demographics of the body politic Lost amid these debates are often the more complex legacies of racial hybridity Anxieties over the disintegration of the fabric of American national identity likewise forget not just how they echo past fears of subversive racial and cultural difference but also exorcise as well the changing nature of work and social interaction Edmund Fong s book examines the rise and resurgence of contemporary forms of American exceptionalism as they have emerged out of contentious debates over cultural pluralism and multicultural diversity in the past two decades For a brief time serious considerations of the force of multiculturalism entered into a variety of philosophical and policy debates But in the American context these debates often led to a reaffirmation of some variant of American exceptionalism with the consequent exorcism of race within the avowed norms and policy goals of American politics Fong explores how this multicultural exorcism revitalizing American exceptionalism is not simply a novel feature of our contemporary political moment but is instead a recurrent dynamic across the history of American political discourse By situating contemporary discourse on cultural pluralism within the larger frame of American history this book yields insight into the production of hegemonic forms of American exceptionalism and how race continues to haunt the contours of American national identity **From Warfare to Welfare** Jennifer S. Contempt and Pity Daryl Michael Scott, 2000-11-09 For over a century the idea that African Americans are psychologically damaged has played an important role in discussions of race In this provocative work Daryl Michael Scott argues that damage imagery has been the product of liberals and conservatives of racists and antiracists While racial conservatives often playing on white contempt for blacks have sought to use findings of black pathology to justify exclusionary policies racial liberals have used damage imagery primarily to promote policies of inclusion and rehabilitation In advancing his argument Scott challenges some long held beliefs about the history of damage imagery He rediscovers the liberal impulses behind Stanley Elkins's Sambo hypothesis and Daniel Patrick Moynihan's Negro Family and exposes the damage imagery in the work of Ralph Ellison the leading anti pathologist He also corrects the view that the Chicago School depicted blacks as pathological products of patriarchy New Negro experts such as Charles Johnson and E Franklin Frazier he says disdained sympathy seeking and refrained from exploring individual pathology Scott's reassessment of social science sheds new light on Brown v Board of Education revealing how experts reversed four decades of theory in order to represent segregation as inherently damaging to blacks In this controversial work Scott warns the Left of the dangers in their recent rediscovery of damage imagery in an age of conservative reform

Beem,2006-01-05 During the 1990s both the United States and Britain shifted from entitlement to work based systems for supporting their poor citizens Much research has examined the implications of welfare reform for the economic well being of the poor but the new legislation also affects our view of democracy and how it ought to function By eliminating entitlement and setting behavioral conditions on aid welfare reform challenges our understanding of citizenship political equality and the role of the state In Welfare Reform and Political Theory editors Lawrence Mead and Christopher Beem have assembled an accomplished list of political theorists social policy experts and legal scholars to address how welfare reform has affected core concepts of political theory and our understanding of democracy itself Welfare Reform and Political Theory is unified by a common set of questions The contributors come from across the political spectrum each bringing different perspectives to bear Carole Pateman argues that welfare reform has compromised the very tenets of democracy by tying the idea of citizenship to participation in the marketplace But William Galston writes that American citizenship has in some respects always been conditioned on good behavior work requirements continue that tradition by promoting individual responsibility and self reliance values essential to a well functioning democracy Desmond King suggests that work requirements draw invidious distinctions among citizens and therefore destroy political equality Amy Wax on the other hand contends that ending entitlement does not harm notions of equality but promotes them by ensuring that no one is rewarded for idleness Christopher Beem argues that entitlement welfare served a social function acknowledging the social value of care that has been lost in the movement towards conditional benefits Stuart White writes that work requirements can be accepted only subject to certain conditions while Lawrence Mead argues that concerns about justice must be addressed only after recipients are working Alan Deacon is well to the left of Joel Schartz but both say government may actively promote virtue through social policy a stance some other contributors reject The move to work centered welfare in the 1990s represented not just a change in government policy but a philosophical change in the way people perceived government its functions and its relationship with citizens Welfare Reform and Political Theory offers a long overdue theoretical reexamination of democracy and citizenship in a workfare society
