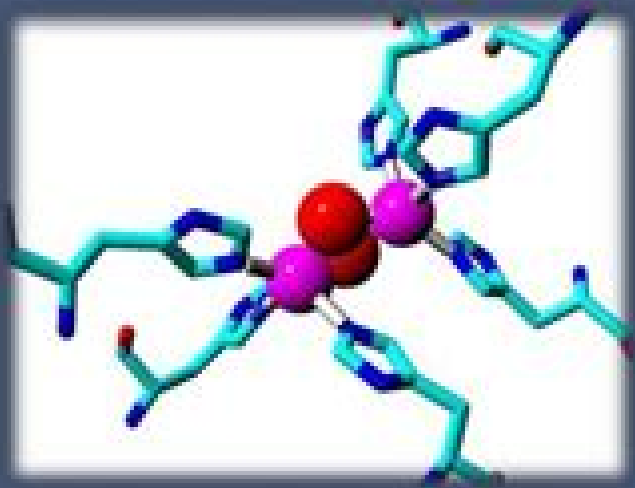
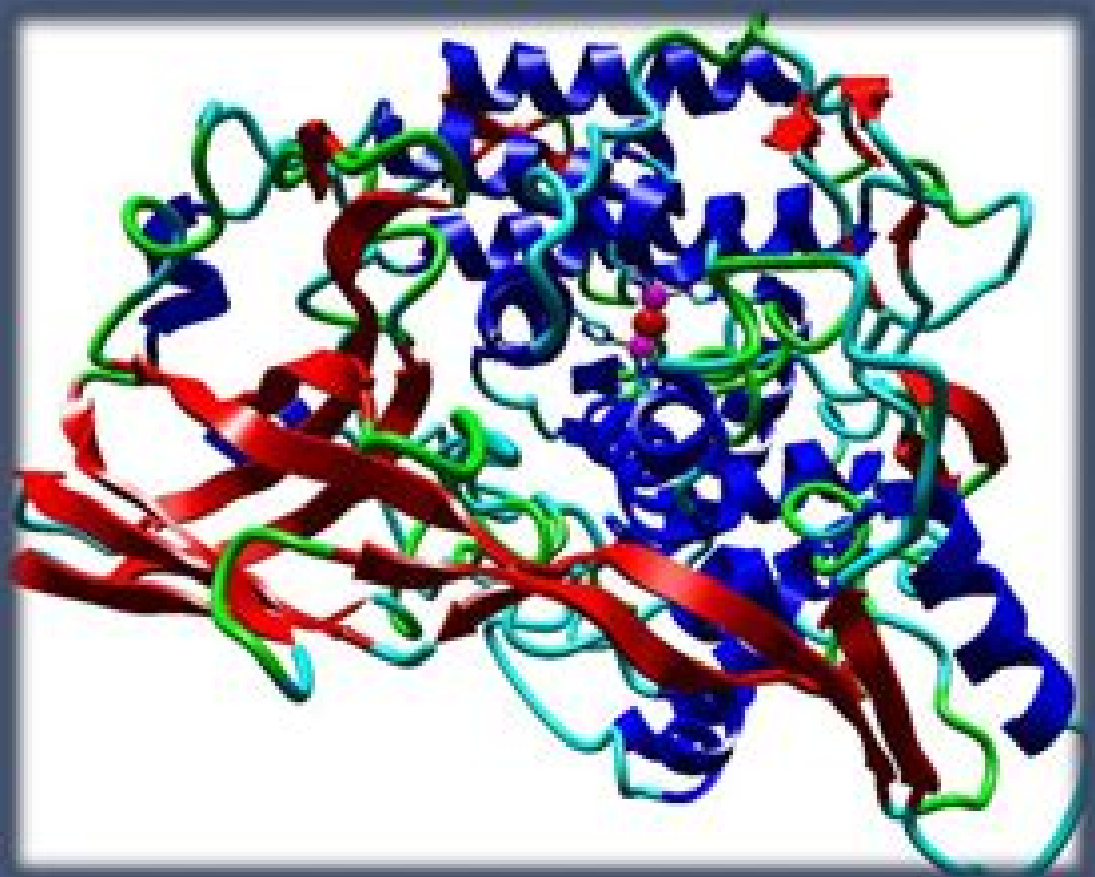


Type III Copper Proteins - Hemocyanin
