Lane, 2002 Over the course of its history the United States has taken great interest in the affairs of its neighbours to the south From the Monroe Doctrine to Grenada to illegal immigration America has been and continues to be an active force in the lives of Caribbean and Central American nations In recent years the relationships have taken an economic turn as witnessed by several pacts like the Caribbean Basin Initiative and NAFTA meant to balance the US dominated relations with these closely packed countries In addition the US has had an enigmatic history with Mexico involving issues like immigration drug smuggling and human rights The public friendship between Presidents George W Bush and Vicente Fox increased optimism for smooth resolutions of US Mexican financial and political concerns However some friction has remained over American border and security worries water usage disputes and the continual problem of narcotics trafficking This book compiles a series of analyses of the varied initiatives and governmental actions linking the US to its nearest southern neighbours present status and evaluated for potential outcomes Such comprehensive studies combined in one book make for a necessary resource in attempting to assess the future course of relations among the Americas

PACTS: The Coalition for Change Bill Collins, 2011-03-29 PACTS The Coalition for Change offers a case study chronicling the efforts of one urban high school district in Northern California to change its curriculum It quantifies surveyed responses solicited from parents administrators curriculum leaders teachers and students in the district It also assesses their level of agreement on issues relating to mathematics reform These agents of change constitute the PACTS Coalition As a group they generally agree that mathematics is a tough subject and that it should be fun however their level of agreement vacillates when the investigation turns to issues such as ability level grouping the incorporation of diversity and the question of inclusion In general members of the alliance believe that the effect of reform efforts has been deleterious to the overall quality of mathematics education at their school site and in the district Many respondents cite poor communication ineffectual leadership and a lack of direction as chief deterrents to effective mathematics reform additionally most agree that cohesion unity and morale among the mathematics staff in the district have suffered as a result Author Bill Collins shows that the varying perspectives of the PACTS Coalition is key to recognizing the complexity of educational issues while revealing the vision needed for lasting education reform

Electoral Rules and Democracy in Latin America Cynthia McClintock, 2018 During Latin America's third democratic wave a majority of countries adopted a runoff rule for the election of the president effectively dampening plurality voting opening the political arena to new parties and assuring the public that the president will never have anything less than majority support In a region in which undemocratic political parties were common and have often been dominated by caudillos cautious naysayers have voiced concerns about the runoff process arguing that a proliferation of new political

parties vying for power is a sign of inferior democracy This book is the first rigorous assessment of the implications of runoff versus plurality rules throughout Latin America and demonstrates that in contrast to early scholarly skepticism about runoff it has been positive for democracy in the region Primarily through qualitative analysis for each country the author argues that indeed an important advantage of runoff is the greater openness of the political arena to new parties at the same time that measures can be taken to inhibit party proliferation In this context it is also the first volume to address whether or not a runoff rule with a reduced threshold for example 40% with a 10 point lead is a felicitous compromise between majority runoff and plurality The book considers the potential for the superiority of runoff to travel beyond Latin America in particular and rather provocatively to the United States
