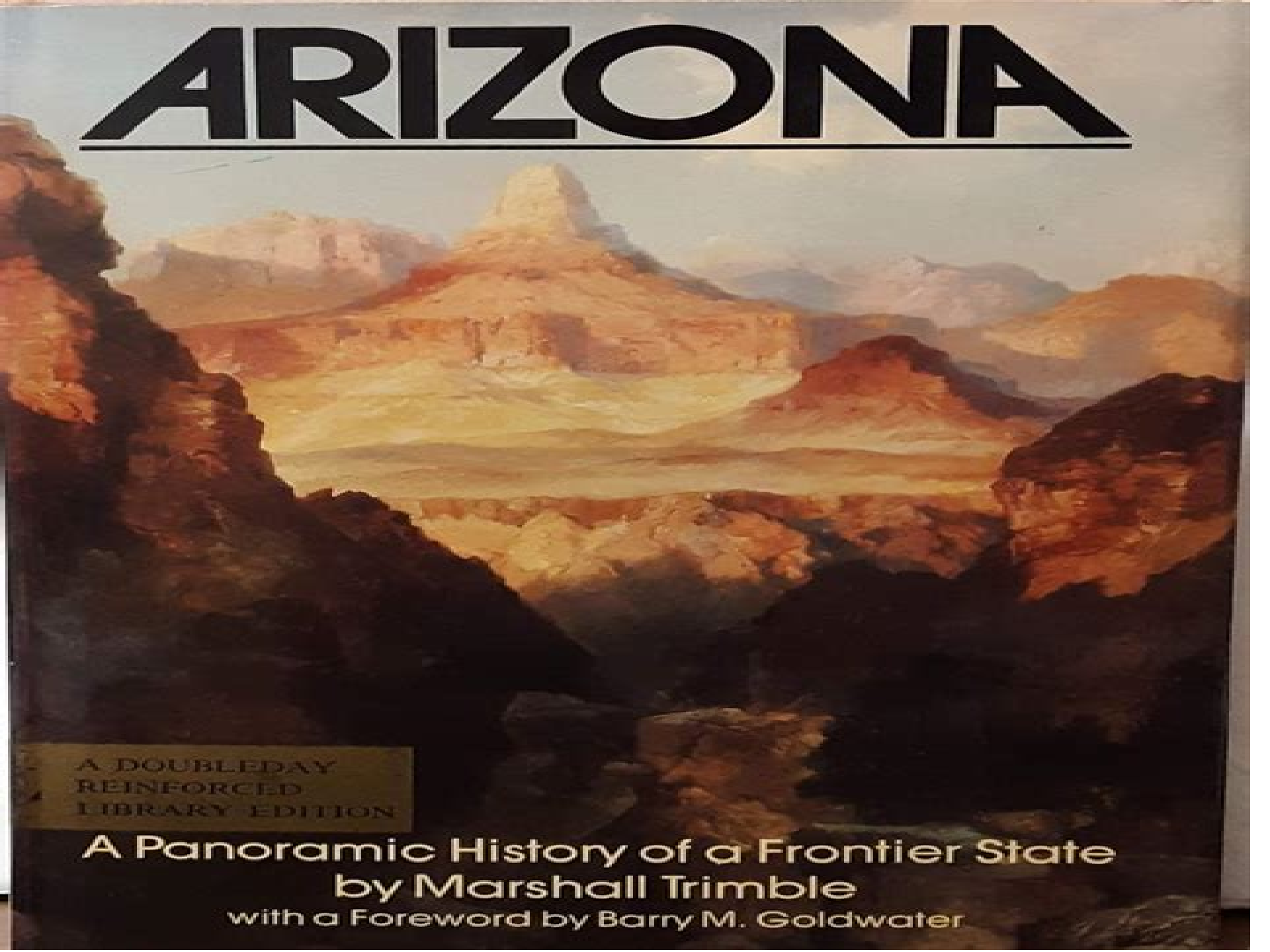

Arizona : a panoramic history of a frontier state Marshall Trimble,1977 **Travels and Researches in Native North America, 1882-1883** Herman Frederik Caryl Kate,2004 This important but little known account of several southwestern tribes has heretofore been available only in the author's native Dutch. Ten Kate's studies of the Pima, Hopi, Apache, and Zuni people are especially noteworthy for their information on tribal cultures. He observed firsthand and sought out informants willing to elaborate on Indian games and sports and on social organization and myths of religious significance. He was particularly interested in the position of women and treatment of children and admired the natives' attitudes on these matters more than did other early anthropologists. His best material is from his extended stay at Zuni where he and Frank Hamilton Cushing became lifelong friends. His observations on the impact of whites on Indian cultures constitute valuable documentation of the dilution of native life styles. Although he is not as well known as contemporaries like Bandelier, Bourke, and Matthews, Ten Kate's work remains influential in the field after more than 120 years. **Arizona** Patrick Lavin,2001 Arizona is a fascinating land of lofty mountains, spectacular canyons, ponderosa forests, living deserts, great rivers, mighty dams, broad mesas, mines, ranches, farms, and orchards, a land of contrasts and contradictions, never fully understood but always loved by those who know the state. Echeverría,2014-03-27 *Aztlán Arizona* is a history of the Chicano Movement in Arizona in the 1960s and 1970s. Focusing on community and student activism in Phoenix and Tucson, Darius V. Echeverría ties the Arizona events to the larger Chicano and civil rights movements against the backdrop of broad societal shifts that occurred throughout the country. Arizona's unique role in the movement came from its public schools, which were the primary source of Chicano activism against the inequities in the judicial, social, economic, medical, political, and educational arenas. The word *Aztlán*, originally meaning the legendary ancestral home of the Nahuatl peoples of Mesoamerica, was adopted as a symbol of independence by Chicano activists during the movement of the 1960s and 1970s. In an era when poverty, prejudice, and considerable oppositional forces blighted the lives of roughly one-fifth of Arizonans, the author argues that understanding those societal realities is essential to defining the rise and power of the Chicano Movement. The book illustrates how Mexican American communities fostered a togetherness that ultimately modified larger Arizona society by revamping the educational history of the region. The concluding chapter outlines key Mexican American individuals and organizations that became politically active in order to address Chicano educational concerns. This Chicano unity reflected in student, parent, and community leadership organizations helped break barriers, dispel the Mexican American inferiority concept, and create educational change that benefited all Arizonans. No other scholar has examined the emergence of Chicano

Movement politics and its related school reform efforts in Arizona Echeverr a s thorough research rich in scope and interpretation is coupled with detailed and exact endnotes The book helps readers understand the issues surrounding the Chicano Movement educational reform and ethnic identity Equally important the author shows how residual effects of these dynamics are still pertinent today in places such as Tucson

Perspectives on Cormac McCarthy Edwin T. Arnold,Dianne C. Luce,2009-10-20 Originally published in 1993 this was the first volume of essays devoted to the works of Cormac McCarthy Immediately it was recognized as a major contribution to studies of this acclaimed American author American Literary Scholarship hailed it as a model of its kind It has since established itself as an essential source for any McCarthy scholar student or serious reader In 1993 McCarthy had recently published *All the Pretty Horses* 1992 the award winning first volume of the Border Trilogy The second volume *The Crossing* appeared in 1994 and the concluding novel *Cities of the Plain* in 1998 The completion of the trilogy one of the most significant artistic achievements in recent American literature calls for further consideration of McCarthy s career This revised volume therefore contains in addition to the original essays an updated version of Gail Morrison s article on *All the Pretty Horses* plus two original essays by the editors of *The Crossing* Luce and *Cities of the Plain* Arnold Except for McCarthy s drama *The Stonemason* 1994 all the major publications are covered in this collection Cormac McCarthy is now firmly established as one of the masters of American literature His first four novels his screenplay *The Gardener s Son* and his drama *The Stonemason* are all set in the South Starting with *Blood Meridian* 1985 he moved west to the border country of Texas and Old and New Mexico to create masterpieces of the western genre Few writers have so completely and successfully described such different locales customs and people Yet McCarthy is no regionalist His work centers on the essential themes of self determination faith courage and the quest for meaning in an often violent and tragic world For his readers wishing to know McCarthy s works this collection is both an introduction and an overview
