Du Bois's Twilight Years Phillip Luke Sinitiere, 2023-06-23 Contributions by Murali Balaji Charisse Burden Stelly Christopher Cameron Carlton Dwayne Floyd Robert Greene II Andre E Johnson Werner Lange Lisa J McLeod Jodi Melamed Tyler Monson Eric Porter Reiland Rabaka Thomas Ehrlich Reifer Camesha Scruggs and Phillip Luke Sinitiere Although the career of W E B Du Bois was remarkable in its entirety a large majority of scholarship focuses on the first five or six decades Overlooked and understudied the closing three decades of Du Bois's career reflect a generative period of his life in terms of teaching travel activism and publications *Forging Freedom in W E B Du Bois's Twilight Years* No Deed but Memory proposes to narrate the political social and cultural significance of Du Bois's career during the controversial closing three decades of his life Du Bois's twilight years were tremendously controversial his persistent criticism of the collusion between capitalism and racism and his choice to join the Communist Party in late 1961 raised the ire of many At the time Du Bois's strident advocacy of socialism and turn to communism during the Cold War oriented most scholars away from delving into his late career While only a few scholars have engaged the productivity of Du Bois's later years the fact is that an anticommunist antiradical animus has followed Du Bois in the half century since his death As a result Du Bois scholarship remains impoverished to the extent that academics neglect his later years The essays in *Forging Freedom in W E B Du Bois's Twilight Years* detail selected aspects of Du Bois's later decades and their particular connection to American social political and cultural history between the 1930s and the 1960s While international concerns and a global perspective also fundamentally defined Du Bois's latter years chronicling his final decades in a US context presents fresh insight into his twilight years Du Bois's commitment to freedom's flourishing during this period animated the Black freedom struggle's war against white supremacy Ultimately this book demonstrates that the durability of Du Bois's intellectual achievements remains relevant to the twenty first century W. Du Bois and His Rivals Raymond Wolters, 2002 W E B Du Bois was the preeminent black scholar of his era He was also a principal founder and for twenty eight years an executive officer of the nation s most effective civil rights organization the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People NAACP Even though Du Bois was best known for his lifelong stance against racial oppression he represented much more He condemned the racism of the white world but also criticized African Americans for mistakes of their own He opposed segregation but had reservations about integration Today he would be known as a pluralist In Du Bois and His Rivals Raymond Wolters provides a distinctive biography of this great pioneer of the American civil rights movement Readers are able to follow the outline of Du Bois s life but the book s main emphasis is on discrete scenes in his life especially the controversies that pitted Du Bois against his principal black rivals He challenged Booker T Washington because he could not abide Washington s conciliatory approach toward powerful whites At the same time Du Bois s pluralism led him to oppose the leading separatists and integrationists of his day He berated Marcus Garvey for giving up on America and urging blacks to pursue a separate destiny He also rejected Walter White s insistence that integration was the best way to promote the

advancement of black people Du Bois felt that American blacks should be full fledged Americans with all the rights of other American citizens However he believed that they should also preserve and develop enough racial distinctiveness to enable them to maintain and foster a sense of racial identity community and pride Du Bois and His Rivals shows that Du Bois stood for much more than protest against racial oppression He was also committed to pluralism and his pluralism emphasized the importance of traditional standards and of internal cooperation within the black community Anyone interested in the civil rights movement black history or the history of the United States during the early twentieth century will find this book valuable

History and Memory in African-American Culture Genevieve Fabre, Robert O'Meally, 1994-12-08 As Nathan Huggins once stated altering American history to account fully for the nation's black voices would change the tone and meaning the frame and the substance of the entire story Rather than a sort of Pilgrim's Progress tale of bold ascent and triumph American history with the black parts told in full would be transmuted into an existential tragedy closer Huggins said to Sartre's No Exit than to the vision of life in Bunyan The relation between memory and history has received increasing attention both from historians and from literary critics In this volume a group of leading scholars has come together to examine the role of historical consciousness and imagination in African American culture The result is a complex picture of the dynamic ways in which African American historical identity constantly invents and transmits itself in literature art oral documents and performances Each of the scholars represented has chosen a different site of memory from a variety of historical and geographical points and from different ideological theoretical and artistic perspectives Yet the book is unified by a common concern with the construction of an emerging African American cultural memory The renowned group of contributors including Hazel Carby Werner Sollors V. V. Schäfer, 2000 This study recreates the intellectual climate and transatlantic setting of turn of the century American reform It examines the influence and meaning of German social thought and reform in the American Reform Movement prior to World War I The American Progressives used the German theories in order to develop and establish new concepts of reform and to base democracy on principles other than possessive individualism utilitarian ethics and market ideology that liberalism held

Amaza Lee Meredith Imagines Herself Modern Jacqueline Taylor, 2023-11-28 The extraordinary life and work of architect Amaza Lee Meredith and the role modernism and material culture played in the aspiring Black American middle class of the early twentieth century Amaza Lee Meredith *Imagines Herself Modern* tells the captivating story of Amaza Lee Meredith a Black woman architect artist and educator born into the Jim Crow South whose bold choices in both life and architecture expand our understanding of the Great Migration and the Harlem Renaissance while revealing the importance of architecture as a force in Black middle class identity Through her charismatic protagonist Jacqueline Taylor derives new insights into the experiences of Black women at the forefront of culture in early twentieth century America caught between expectation and ambition responsibility and desire Central to Taylor s argument is that Meredith s response to modern architecture and art like those of other Black cultural producers was not marginal to the modernist project instead her work reveals the tensions and inconsistencies in how American modernism has been defined In this way the book shines a necessary light on modernism s complexity while overturning perceived notions of race and gender in relation to the modernist project and challenging the notion of the white male hero of modern architecture

of entire works and longer selections of major works than any other anthology of its kind This second volume contains a comprehensive collection of texts authored by African Americans from the 1920s to the present The two volumes of this landmark anthology can also be bought as a set at over 20% savings *The Black Atlantic* Paul Gilroy, 1993 Afrocentrism Eurocentrism Caribbean Studies British Studies To the forces of cultural nationalism hunkered down in their camps this bold hook sounds a liberating call There is Paul Gilroy tells us a culture that is not specifically African American Caribbean or British but all of these at once a black Atlantic culture whose themes and techniques transcend ethnicity and nationality to produce something new and until now unremarked Challenging the practices and assumptions of cultural studies The Black Atlantic also complicates and enriches our understanding of modernism Debates about postmodernism have cast an unfashionable pall over questions of historical periodization Gilroy bucks this trend by arguing that the development of black culture in the Americas and Europe is a historical experience which can be called modern for a number of clear and specific reasons For Hegel the dialectic of master and slave was integral to modernity and Gilroy considers the implications of this idea for a transatlantic culture In search of a poetics reflecting the politics and history of this culture he takes us on a transatlantic tour of the music that for centuries has transmitted racial messages and feeling around the world from the Jubilee Singers in the nineteenth century to Jimi Hendrix to rap He also explores this internationalism as it is manifested in black writing from the double consciousness of W E B Du Bois to the double vision of Richard Wright to the compelling voice of Toni Morrison In a final tour de force Gilroy exposes the shared contours of black and Jewish concepts of diaspora in order both to establish a theoretical basis for healing rifts between blacks and Jews in contemporary culture and to further define the central theme of his book that blacks have shaped a nationalism if not a nation within the shared culture of the black Atlantic

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
