Katlic, 2013-06-29 More than two decades ago in response to the special healthcare needs of the aging American population interest in the field of geriatric medicine began to grow and blossom in the United States In 1984 and 1985 under the editorial leadership of Christine K Cassel and William R

Hazzard respectively two major textbooks devoted to the medical care of aged patients were published These scholarly comprehensive texts provided insight into the principles of aging and guidance in the care of the geriatric patient Three editions later the need to understand the special issues involved in the medical care of the elderly is widely accepted by internists primary care providers and medical specialists For the editors of this book the special issues involved in the surgical care of the elderly have been apparent for nearly as long Although there have been a few scholarly texts on the subject including one in 1990 by Mark R Katlic general acceptance of the concept of geriatric surgery by our surgical and medical colleagues has however lagged This is not the result of a proportionately smaller number of older patients with surgical disease because cancer cardiovascular disease and orthopedic problems are diseases of the aged It is rather the result of uncertainty about the value of surgery in the elderly and concerns about the risks of operations In the past such concerns prevented primary care givers from referring patients for surgical care and prevented surgeons from agreeing to operate
