group in spite of representing a small non Arab and Christian minority within a very different mostly Arab and Muslim environment The author shows that while in Lebanon the state has facilitated the development of an extensive and effective system of Armenian ethno cultural preservation in Syria the emergence of centralizing authoritarian regimes in the 1950s and 1960s has severely damaged the autonomy and cultural diversity of the Armenian community Since 1970 the coming to power of the Asad family has contributed to a partial recovery of Armenian ethno cultural diversity as the community seems to have developed some form of tacit arrangement with the regime In Lebanon on the other hand the Armenian community suffered the consequences of the recurrent breakdown of the consociational arrangement that regulates public life In both cases the survival of Armenian cultural distinctiveness seems to be connected rather incidentally with the continuing search for legitimacy of the state
