Women's Identities at War Susan R. Grayzel, 2014-03-19 There are few moments in history when the division between the sexes seems as natural as during wartime men go off to the war front while women stay behind on the home front But the very notion of the home front was an invention of the First World War when for the first time home and domestic became adjectives that modified the military term front Such an innovation acknowledged the significant and presumably new contributions of civilians especially women to the war effort Yet as Susan Grayzel argues throughout the war traditional notions of masculinity and femininity survived primarily through the maintenance of and indeed reemphasis on soldiering and mothering as the core of gender and national identities Drawing on sources that range from popular fiction and war memorials to newspapers and legislative debates Grayzel analyzes the effects of World War I on ideas about civic participation national service morality sexuality and identity in wartime Britain and France Despite the appearance of enormous challenges to gender roles due to the upheavals of war the forces of stability prevailed she says demonstrating the Western European gender system's remarkable resilience

World War Haytock explores what war and domestic texts represent in light of the deconstructionist said in its cultural and historical context and seeing what is not said Readers take food shelter and clothing for granted and yet the way we treat them is part of what allows us to define ourselves as civilized In war novels and domestic novels by Temple Beiley Ellen Glasgow Edith Wharton Willa Cather John Dos Passons Thomas Boyd Ernest Hemingway William Faulkner and Eudora Welty the idea of home and domestic rituals contribute to the creation of war propaganda the soldier s experience of war and the home front s ability to confront the war after the fact This approach helps literary criticism reject the separation of men s and women s writing particularly but not only their writing about war

present **Disloyal Mothers and Scurrilous Citizens** Kathleen Kennedy,1999-09-22 A concise and highly readable study of women s influence on a crucial era in American political and cultural history Kathleen Kennedy s unique study explores the arrests trials and defenses of women charged under the Wartime Emergency Laws passed soon after the US entered World War I These women often members of the political left whose anti war or pro labor activity brought them to the attention of federal officials made up ten percent of the approximately two thousand Federal Espionage cases Their trials became important arenas in which women s relationships and obligations to national security were contested and defined Anti radical politics raised questions about the state s role in defining motherhood and social reproduction Kennedy shows that state authorities often defined women s subversion as a violation of their maternal roles Yet with the exception of Kate Richards O Hare the women charged with sedition did not define their political behavior within the terms set by maternalism Instead they used liberal arguments of equality justice and democratic citizenship to argue for their right to speak frankly about American policy Such claims while often in opposition to strategies outlined by their defense teams helped form the framework for modern arguments made in defense of civil liberties Male Subjectivity at the Margins Kaja

1850-1872 Lyde Cullen Sizer,2003-06-19 This volume explores the lives and works of nine Northern women who wrote during the Civil War period examining the ways in which through their writing they engaged in the national debates of the time Lyde Sizer shows that from the 1850 publication of Uncle Tom s Cabin through Reconstruction these women as well as a larger mosaic of lesser known writers used their mainstream writings publicly to make sense of war womanhood Union slavery republicanism heroism and death Among the authors discussed are Lydia Maria Child Harriet Beecher Stowe Sara Willis Parton Fanny Fern Frances Ellen Watkins Harper Mrs E D E N Southworth Mary Abigail Dodge Gail Hamilton Louisa May Alcott Rebecca Harding Davis and Elizabeth Stuart Phelps Although direct political or partisan power was denied to women these writers actively participated in discussions of national issues through their sentimental novels short stories essays poetry and letters to the editor Sizer pays close attention to how these mostly middle class women attempted to create a rhetoric of unity giving common purpose to women despite differences in class race and politics This theme of unity was ultimately deployed to establish a white middle class standard of womanhood meant to exclude as well as include

Radical Visions Vicente F. Gotera,1994 Although poets have written about warfare since at least the time of Homer the Vietnam war has struck many observers as being immune to the interpretations of poetry and myth Lyric poetry of a traditional kind writes one critic has proved inappropriate to communicate the character of the Vietnam war its remoteness

its jargonized recapitulations its seeming imperviousness to aesthetics Nonetheless the past two decades have seen an unprecedented outpouring of poetry that seeks to describe and come to terms with that bitterly divisive conflict In *Radical Visions* Vince Gotera argues that poetry written by Vietnam veterans underlines the failure of traditional American myths to help Americans understand the war and its aftermath The book blends sociohistorical commentary with close readings of individual works by such poets as Michael Casey Walter McDonald and W D Ehrhart In the book's first section *The Nam* Gotera examines several key mythic structures the Wild West a violent extension of the mythic virgin land the machine in the garden the city on the hill regeneration through violence all of which helped delude Americans about Vietnam and the war being fought there In the second part *The World* Gotera shows how another myth the American Adam as an exemplar of ahistorical innocence proved unusable for returning veterans attempting to readjust to American life In addition to exposing these failed myths Gotera argues the poetry by Vietnam veterans reflects an effort to construct new myths most notably that of the warrior against war an oxymoronic structure arising from the difficulties faced by returning veterans In the book's final chapters Gotera examines the work of Bruce Weigl and Yusef Komunyakaa two poets whom the author considers most successful at portraying the moral absurdity of the Vietnam war without sacrificing lyrical aesthetics The first comprehensive study devoted exclusively to poetry by Vietnam veterans *Radical Visions* argues that this body of writing registers an important advance in the aesthetics and poetics of war literature and offers a cogent antiwar statement rooted in personal experience

Touch and Intimacy in First World War Literature Santanu Das, 2006-04-06 The First World War ravaged the male body on an unprecedented scale yet fostered moments of physical intimacy and tenderness among the soldiers in the trenches Touch the most elusive and private of the senses became central to war experience War writing is haunted by experiences of physical contact from the muddy realities of the front to the emotional intensity of trench life to the traumatic obsession with the wounded body in nurses' memoirs Through extensive archival and historical research analysing previously unknown letters and diaries alongside literary writings by figures such as Owen and Brittain Santanu Das recovers the sensuous world of the First World War trenches and hospitals This original and evocative study alters our understanding of the period as well as of the body at war and illuminates the perilous intimacy between sense experience emotion and language as we try to make meaning in times of crisis

Women at Work in World Wars I and II Paul Chrystal, 2024-04-04 This book is about women in World Wars I II women working in factories and on farms or toiling perilously in field stations just behind the front lines in inhospitable hospitals and convalescent homes It is therefore about the prodigious contribution women made to the war efforts from 1914 1918 and 1939 1945 standing in for the men who had left their places of work for the various theatres of war from Greece and Italy to Belgium from Mesopotamia to France Their tasks were many and various keeping the troops supplied with shells bullets and explosives keeping the nation from starving to death keeping hundreds of thousands of wounded troops alive so that they might fight another day The book is in short the

uplifting but sometimes tragic story of the many women who stepped up to work in the factories hospitals field stations in transport and in civil defense on the farms and shipyards or signed up to the various military and civil services during the two world wars of the 20th century wars to end all wars The book is different because it deals with women s labour in both world wars and in all occupations it covers the discrimination and prejudice they faced from men at every level military and civilian even when they had demonstrated beyond doubt that they were quick learners industrious and proficient and usually as good as any man The book raises the embarrassing question why it has taken so long for the prodigious contribution women made in both wars to be recognized and why some women workers still remain air brushed from our military history after more than a century As it turned out little was beyond their capabilities and it is reasonable to suppose that without their huge efforts and accomplishments both wars might have turned out very differently for us **City Images** Mary Ann Caws, 2013-11-26 First Published in 1991 Knowing any real city and still more so knowing what it is to know a city may be as much about passive as about active experience What we read in the field that field of the city in all its bizarre mixture of culture and nature is bound to determine to some non fictional extent what we know of it what we imagine it could be what we fear it may be or become These essays are meant to be albeit in their critical mode the recountings of knowing something through something else they are the projected imagination through reading of the reading by the self and or others a wide range of each of a city or cities as such of what city knowing or city thinking is The city as stage market and labyrinth variously trafficked and aestheticized dreamt and politicized as passionately written by authors from Cicero to Kazin from Wordsworth Dickens Whitman and Woolf to Williams Ashbery and Bonnefoy is the place the essays play themselves out through architecture and metaphor *Heroines and Heroes: Symbolism, Embodiment, Narratives & Identity* Christopher Hart, 2008

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
