Cracked Coverage Jimmie Lynn Reeves, Richard Campbell, 1994 Carefully documenting the deceptions and excesses of television news coverage of the so called cocaine epidemic Cracked Coverage stands as a bold indictment of the backlash politics of the Reagan coalition and its implicit racism the mercenary outlook of the drug control establishment and the enterprising reporting of crusading journalism Blending theoretical and empirical analyses Jimmie L Reeves and Richard Campbell explore how TV news not only interprets reality in ways that reflect prevailing ideologies but is in many respects responsible for constructing that reality Their examination of the complexity of television and its role in American social cultural and political conflict is focused specifically on the ways in which American television during the Reagan years helped stage and legitimate the war on drugs one of the great moral panics of the postwar era.
