

1812 WAR

A week after the United States declared war on Britain, on June 26, 1812, Secretary of State James Monroe wrote to Jonathan Russell, the American charge d'affaires in London, to inform and instruct him. Monroe remarked that it could be "difficult to relinquish territory which had been conquered," in one of the war's most quoted sound bites. This quotation frequently occurs in general histories of the United States as proof of expansionism towards Canada, and it may be a significant piece of evidence in our examination of the War of 1812's underlying reasons as opposed to its apparent ones. Instead of going to war openly, Great Britain and Napoleonic France waged an economic war in which they attempted to starve each other into submission by obstructing each other's trade networks.

The British and French economic sanctions against the United States during the Napoleonic Wars, together with American indignation at the British practice of impressment—particularly following the 1807 Chesapeake incident—were the direct causes of the War of 1812. American trade was severely disrupted by British orders in council in 1806, therefore the country initially attempted several counter embargoes. Not only did Madison destroy American trade, but it also almost brought the Democratic-Republican Party to its knees. Madison assumed total control of the party in 1808.

War Hawks

Young "War hawks" who were willing to take drastic measures against Great Britain were John C. Calhoun of South Carolina, Felix Grundy of Tennessee, and Henry Clay of Kentucky in the 12th Congress. Among these new national leaders was Henry Clay, who started pushing for war with Britain right away. He attributed the ongoing hostilities with the aboriginal people in the West to the British.
