The first problem is the ray shooting problem preprocess a set of polyhedra into a data structure such that the first polyhedron that is hit by a guery ray can be determined guickly The second problem is that of computing depth orders we want to sort a set of polyhedra such that of one polyhedron is partially obscured by another polyhedron then it comes first in the order The third problem is the hidden surface removal problem given a set of polyhedra and a view point compute which parts of the polyhedra are visible from the view point These three problems involve issues that are fundamental to three dimensional computational geometry. The book also contains a large introductory part discussing the techniques used to tackle the problems This part should interest not only those who need the background for the rest of the book but also anyone who wants to know more about some recent techniques in computational geometry
