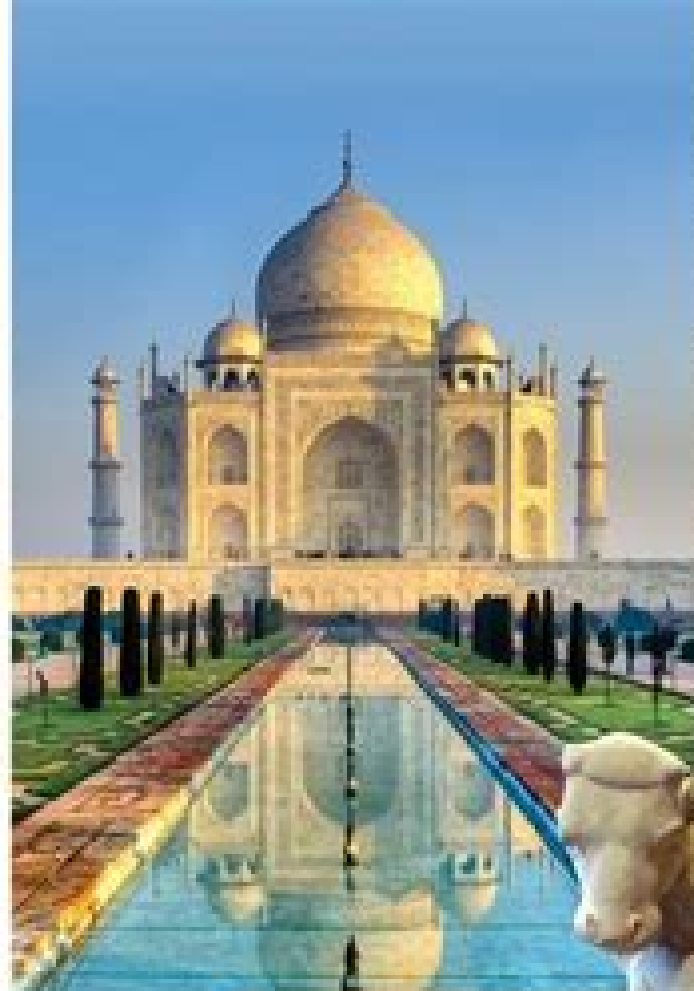




Art In World History
