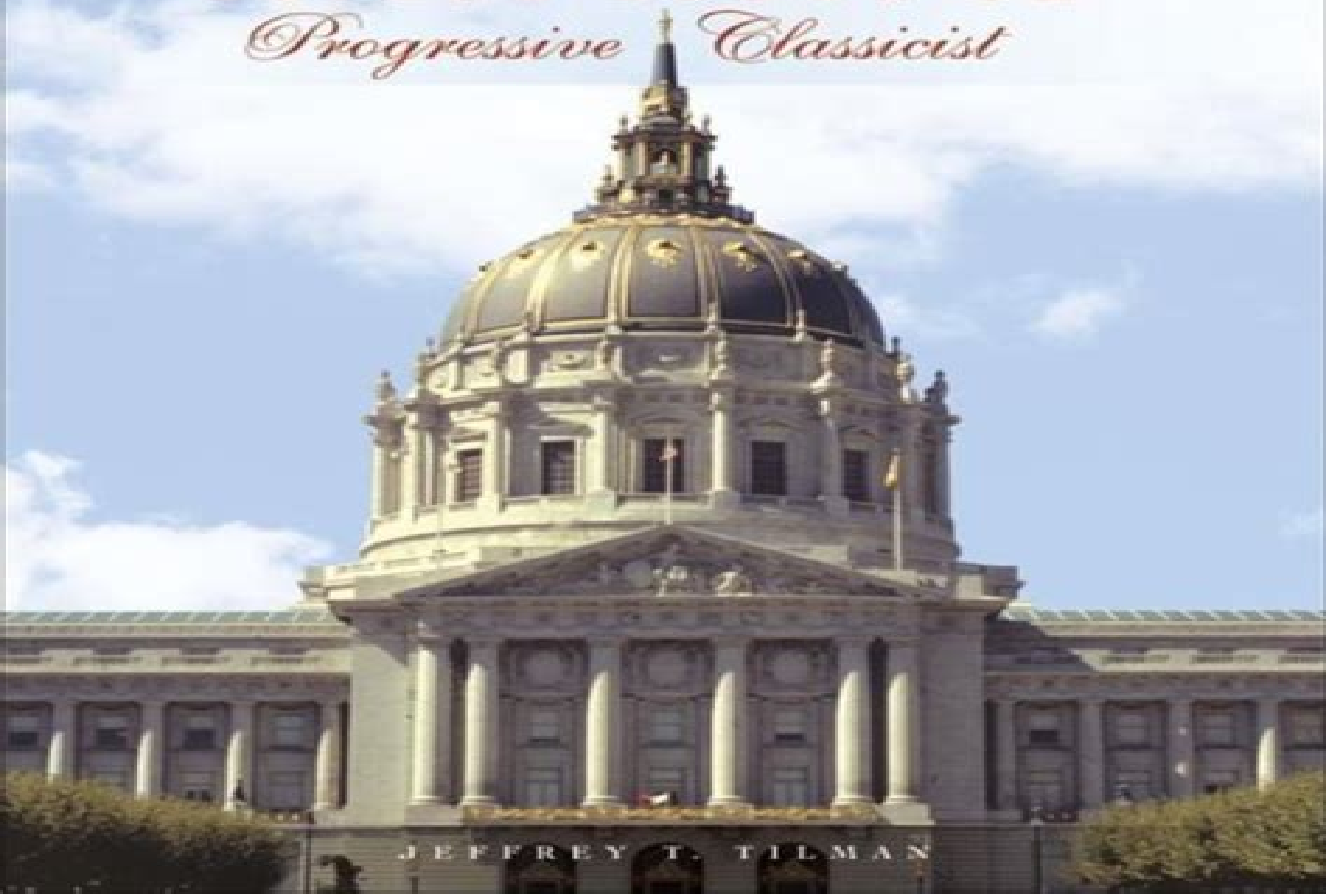

Arthur Brown, Jr Jeffrey T. Tilman, Arthur Brown, 2006 Arthur Brown Jr 1874 1957 is one of the most important yet underpublished architects of the twentieth century The Secrets of Architectural Composition Nathaniel Cortland Curtis, 2013-09-02 Well arranged logical and aptly illustrated this classic survey covers every aspect of the design process It addresses architectural principles as well as their practical application examining general questions of scale balance proportion and symmetry and presenting detailed treatments of doors windows walls stairways columns and other features Long acknowledged as a valuable resource for students and teachers alike this volume is unsurpassed in terms of the richness of its material and the consistency of its insights It was written by Nathaniel Cortlandt Curtis an influential designer and artist who served as the head of the Tulane School of Architecture Curtis illustrated his work with nearly 250 line drawings that depict architectural elements from a splendid variety of periods and settings from ancient Rome s temples and palaces to modern day hotels and museums of Paris and New York **Secrets of Good Design for Artists, Artisans and Crafters** Burl N. Osburn, 2013-12-10 Practical and aesthetically pleasing this visual meditation on the constituents of good design considers all manner of construction form and ornamentation It answers many questions about design choices from basic to specific with clear concise and practical directions The book s appeal lies chiefly in the integrity of its own design consisting of hand lettered text and pleasingly styled and proportioned illustrations Author Burl N Osburn addresses basic questions What are the qualities of good design and how does balance affect design What is good proportion and how is ornament used and explores design choices in a variety of expressions Featured arts and crafts include the use of wrought iron methods of cutting wood the decoration of clay and leather the basic textile structures the nature of the tapestry weave and design of block printed textile the development of repeat pattern and the geometry of repeating ornament and attaining typographic unity Students learn to analyze a project s requirements draw up specifications and design the final product A valuable guide for teachers and students this volume also constitutes a practical resource for professional and amateur artists and crafters **The Vatican and Saint Peter's Basilica of Rome** Paul Letarouilly, 2010 French architect Paul Letarouilly 1795 1855 author of the masterpiece Edifices de Rome Moderne was unequalled in his observational ability and impeccable drawing skills He devoted many years of his life living in austerity and refusing paying commissions to compile and draw the intricate details and decorative elements of the most breathtaking buildings in Italy s Vatican City including St Peter s Basilica the Sistine Chapel the Pontifical Palace the Museo Pio Clementino and the Villa Pia Published in 1882 after his death Vatican served as an unparalleled sourcebook of everything from plans elevations interior room views and perspective drawings to mosaics wall panels door frames fountains towers domes cornices and moldings Prior to the books original publication these details were not easily replicated in other parts of the world Vatican gave access to rigorous documentation of the work of some of the most significant Renaissance architects Michelangelo Bernini Bramante Sangallo

and Peruzzi and is now often credited as one of the primary catalysts for the American Renaissance style the results of which can be seen in any capital city in America The precision and attention to detail that Letarouilly demanded of his engravers advanced the art of etching in the nineteenth century Exquisite rendering techniques and precise execution make this book as beautiful as it is useful Originally published in three volumes Vatican is presented as a single facsimile edition in our Classic Reprints series and includes a new foreword by architectural historian Ingrid Rowland Published in association with the Institute of Classical Architecture and Classical America *The Grove Encyclopedia of American Art* Joan M. Marter, 2011 Arranged in alphabetical order these 5 volumes encompass the history of the cultural development of America with over 2300 entries CARMEL-BY-THE-SEA, THE EARLY YEARS (1903-1913) Alissandra Dramov, 2013 Carmel by the Sea The Early Years 1903 1913 describes the establishment of Carmel by the Sea California along with an overview of the history of the Carmel Mission and the Monterey Peninsula The book's emphasis is on the development of Carmel as a Bohemian artists and writers colony at the start of the 20th century The town's first decade of existence is described the businesses and services offered and the residential architecture There are biographies of the well known Bohemian artists writers poets builders and other notable residents and visitors in the early 1900's This original group of settlers the majority of whom came from Northern California's Bay Area were distinctive individuals who were drawn to the coastal village by its scenic beauty and the inspiration it provided for their intellectual pursuits They set the tone that made Carmel by the Sea a Bohemian enclave on the West Coast and distinguished it as a unique place These early residents and visitors left a significant and lasting impact on the future of the seaside town which in turn attracted other creative talents to the area through the years and still to this day Carmel by the Sea The Early Years 1903 1913 preserves the literary artistic cultural and architectural heritage of Carmel and the Monterey Peninsula region **Paris on the Potomac** Cynthia R. Field, Isabelle Gournay, Thomas P. Somma, 2013-02-04 In 1910 John Mervin Carr re a Paris trained American architect wrote Learning from Paris made Washington outstanding among American cities The five essays in Paris on the Potomac explore aspects of this influence on the artistic and architectural environment of Washington D C which continued long after the well known contributions of Peter Charles L. Enfant the transplanted French military officer who designed the city's plan Isabelle Gournay's introductory essay provides an overview and examines the context and issues involved in three distinct periods of French influence the classical and Enlightenment principles that prevailed from the 1790s through the 1820s the Second Empire style of the 1850s through the 1870s and the Beaux Arts movement of the early twentieth century William C. Allen and Thomas P. Somma present two case studies Allen on the influence of French architecture especially the Halle aux Blés on Thomas Jefferson's vision of the U.S. Capitol and Somma on David d'Angers's busts of George Washington and the Marquis de Lafayette Liana Paredes offers a richly detailed examination of French inspired interior decoration in the homes of Washington's elite in the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries Cynthia R. Field concludes the volume with a

consideration of the influence of Paris on city planning in Washington D C including the efforts of the McMillan Commission and the later development of the Federal Triangle complex The essays in this collection the latest addition to the series Perspectives on the Art and Architectural History of the United States Capitol originated in a conference held by the U S Capitol Historical Society in 2002 at the French Embassy s Maison Fran aise

The Coit Tower Murals Robert W. Cherny, 2024-11-12 Created in 1934 the Coit Tower murals were sponsored by the Public Works of Art Project PWAP the first of the New Deal art programs Twenty five master artists and their assistants worked there most of them in buon fresco Nearly all of them drew upon the palette and style of Diego Rivera The project boosted the careers of Victor Arnautoff Lucien Labaudt Bernard Zakheim and others but Communist symbols in a few murals sparked the first of many national controversies over New Deal art Sixty full color photographs illustrate Robert Cherny s history of the murals from their conception and completion through their evolution into a beloved San Francisco landmark Cherny traces and critiques the treatment of the murals by art critics and historians He also probes the legacies of Coit Tower and the PWAP before surveying San Francisco s recent controversies over New Deal murals An engaging account of an artistic landmark The Coit Tower Murals tells the full story behind a public art masterpiece

Schmidt, 2013-05-27 A treasure trove of measured drawings and photographs this volume depicts wood fences gates and small garden houses of New England Several of these elegantly detailed constructions were built between the Revolutionary War and 1825 and many of them no longer exist Restorationists and preservationists will find this collection a valuable resource

Hoover Tower at Stanford University Elena S. Danielson ,2018-08-06 A Stanford University landmark since 1941 the 285 foot tall Art Deco style Hoover Tower provides a contrasting focal point for the horizontal lines of the Quad s sandstone arcades The Quad begun in 1887 and designed in Richardsonian Romanesque style was only partially completed for the first class of students in 1891 One of those students was 17 year old Herbert Hoover 1874 1964 Hoover graduated in 1895 and began his career in mining During World War I he shifted his energies to providing food relief in war torn Europe Prior to becoming US president 1929 1933 Hoover had started collecting vast documentation on international relations global economics war revolution and peace After the presidency he built Hoover Tower on his beloved campus to house this growing library collection Arthur Brown Jr 1874 1957 designed the library building which was dedicated to promote peace in the world Both Alexander Kerensky and later Alexander Solzhenitsyn had offices in Hoover Tower With its growing collection of research materials the tower is the architectural focus of a vibrant public policy center that attracts scholars and distinguished public servants such as US secretaries of state George P Shultz and Condoleezza Rice and has hosted visiting foreign leaders such as Margaret Thatcher and Hu Jintao

Art Deco San Francisco Therese Poletti, 2008-09-03 The Castro Theatre the Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Headquarters 450 Sutter Medico Dental Building these masterpieces of San Francisco s Art Deco heritage are the work of one man Timothy Pflueger An immigrant s

son with only a grade school education Pflueger began practicing architecture after San Francisco's 1906 earthquake. While his contemporaries looked to Beaux Arts traditions to rebuild the city, he brought exotic Mayan, Asian, and Egyptian forms to buildings ranging from simple cocktail lounges to the city's first skyscrapers. Pflueger was one of the city's most prolific architects during his 40-year career. He designed two major downtown skyscrapers, two stock exchanges, several neighborhood theaters, movie palaces, and four smaller cities, including the beloved Paramount in Oakland, some of the city's biggest schools, and at least 50 homes. His works include the San Francisco Stock Exchange, the ever popular Top of the Mark, the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge, and the San Francisco World's Fair. It is a testament to his talent that many of his buildings still stand and many have been named landmarks. Therese Poletti tells the fascinating story of Pflueger's life and work in Art Deco San Francisco. In lively detail, she relates how Pflueger built extravagant compositions in metal, concrete, and glass. She also tells the story behind the architecture Pflueger's commissioning and support of muralist Diego Rivera, his association with photographer Ansel Adams, and sculptor Ralph Stackpole, and his childhood friendship turned to adulthood sponsorship with San Francisco Mayor James "Sunny" Rolph Jr. Beautiful archival photography mixes with stunning new photography in this collection of a truly Californian but ultimately American story.

In the company of his son Randolph, his brother Jack, and his nephew Johnny, he toured Canada and the United States. Notable are Churchill's meetings with political, business, newspaper, and entertainment figures: President Hoover, Prime Minister Mackenzie King, Bernard Baruch, William Randolph Hearst, Marion Davies, and Charlie Chaplin, as well as his visits to such landmarks as the Grand Canyon, Lake Louise, Niagara Falls, and Yosemite. The Churchills also visited a lumber camp, slaughterhouse, and steel factory; went fishing on the Pacific Ocean; and inspected the battlefields in Quebec and Virginia. They evaded Prohibition and gambled on the stock market about to crash. It was on this trip that Churchill gained an understanding of the two countries firsthand and deepened his feelings for Canada and the United States.
