E. Cummings Gregory Corso and Stevie Smith He was a regular contributor to BBC Radio 3 and was widely read as a critic on the Gramophone He was an Emeritus Professor of the Universities of Keele and London and was chair of the

Bernarr Rainbow Trust for which he edited several books on music education
