students of Woolf or Forster or Keynes or Strachey who need to know the background of those writers *The Lost Girls* Andrew Radford,2007-01-01 *The Lost Girls* analyses a number of British writers between 1850 and 1930 for whom the myth of Demeter's loss and eventual recovery of her cherished daughter Kore Persephone swept off in violent and catastrophic captivity by Dis God of the Dead had both huge personal and aesthetic significance This book in addition to scrutinising canonical and less well known texts by male authors such as Thomas Hardy E M Forster and D H Lawrence also focuses on unjustly neglected women writers Mary Webb and Mary Butts who utilised occult tropes to relocate themselves culturally and especially in Butts's case to recover and restore a forgotten legacy the myth of matriarchal origins These novelists are placed in relation not only to one another but also to Victorian archaeologists and especially to Jane Ellen Harrison 1850 1928 one of the first women to distinguish herself in the history of British Classical scholarship and whose anthropological approach to the study of early Greek art and religion both influenced and became transformed by the literature Rather than offering a teleological argument that moves lock step through the decades *The Lost Girls* proposes chapters that detail specific engagements with Demeter Persephone through which to register distinct literary cultural shifts in uses of the myth and new insights into the work of particular writers **A Spiritual Bloomsbury** Antony Copley,2006-08-04 *A Spiritual Bloomsbury* is an exploration of how three English writers Edward Carpenter E M Forster and Christopher Isherwood sought to come to terms with their homosexuality by engagement with Hinduism Copley reveals how these writers came to terms with their inner conflicts and were led in the direction of Hinduism by friendship or the influence of gurus Tackling the themes of the guru disciple relationship their quarrel with Christianity relationships with their mothers and the problematic feminine the tensions between sexuality and society and the attraction of Hindu mysticism this fascinating work seeks to reveal whether Hinduism offered the answers and fulfillment these writers ultimately sought Also included is a diary narrating Copley's quest to track down Carpenter's and Isherwood's Vedantism and Forster's Krishna cult on a journey to India An E. M. Forster Chronology J. Stape,2016-07-27 This chronology provides a concise and accurate outline of Forster's personal literary and intellectual life from year to year in a series of crisply written diary entries While the main focus is on his career as a writer of fiction most of which falls between 1901 and 1924 the chronicle format also sheds new light on the extent and nature of Forster's political and public commitments during his middle years and into an active old age Travel friendships and wide reading are also documented to achieve a coherent picture of a full life Drawing on numerous unpublished sources including widely scattered letters and the Forster archive at King's College Cambridge this chronology makes available a wealth of new information about Forster the man and writer *Sea-changes: Melville - Forster - Britten* Hanna Rochlitz,2012 E M Forster first encountered Billy Budd in 1926 Some twenty years later he embarked on a collaboration with Benjamin Britten and Eric Crozier adapting Melville's novella for the opera stage The libretto they produced poignantly reaffirms the Forsterian creed of salvation through personal relationships This study

presents an extensive exploration of Forster's involvement in the interpretation transformation and re-creation of Melville's text. It situates the story of the Handsome Sailor in the wider context of Forster's literary oeuvre, his life and his life writings. In detailed readings, *Billy Budd* becomes a lens through which the themes, patterns and leitmotifs of Forsterian thought and creative imagination are brought into focus. A close re-examination of the libretto sketches serves to shed new light on the collaborative process in which Melville's story was changed to fit an archetypal array of plot and character types that is central to Forster's own storytelling.

'Light that Dances in the Mind' Graham Smith, 2007. This book is concerned with the presence of familiar objects in unfamiliar places. It examines the literary practice of inserting imaginary photographs of art, architecture and people into novels and short stories. These photographs are fictive objects, although some, especially those of art and architecture, have equivalents in real life. The book examines the presence of invented photographs in the writings of six authors who made extensive use of this practice. The first part of the book concentrates on E. M. Forster while also including some discussion of imaginary photographs in Sinclair Lewis's novel *Main Street*. The second part of the book analyses the uses of photographs in the writings of Forster's near contemporaries, with separate chapters being devoted to Henry James, Marcel Proust, James Joyce and Virginia Woolf. An epilogue touches on Christopher Isherwood, a member of the next generation of British writers. The book focuses upon largely unexplored areas in the writings of these authors: what Virginia Woolf in *Modern Fiction* styled 'unexpected places'.

Sciences of Modernism Paul Peppis, 2014-02-28. *Sciences of Modernism* examines key points of contact between British literature and the human sciences of ethnography, sexology and psychology at the dawn of the twentieth century. The book is divided into sections that pair exemplary scientific texts from the period with literary ones, charting numerous collaborations and competitions occurring between science and early modernist literature. Paul Peppis investigates this exchange through close readings of literary works by Claude McKay, E. M. Forster, Mina Loy, Rebecca West and Wilfred Owen alongside science books by Alfred Haddon, Havelock Ellis, Marie Stopes, Bernard Hart and William Brown. In so doing, Peppis shows how these competing disciplines participated in the formation and consolidation of modernism as a broad cultural movement across a range of critical discourses. His study will interest students and scholars of the history of science, literary modernism and English literature more broadly.

Difficult Rhythm Michelle Fillion, 2010. *Difficult Rhythm* examines E. M. Forster's irrepressible interest in music, providing plentiful examples of how the eminent British author's fiction resonates with music. Musicologist Michelle Fillion analyzes his critical writings, short stories and novels, including *A Room with a View*, which alludes to Beethoven, Wagner and Schumann, and *Howards End*, which explicitly alerts readers how fiction can adopt musical forms and ideas. Burdens of Intimacy Christopher Lane,1999 Why does passion bewilder and torment so many Victorian protagonists And why do so many literary characters experience moments of ecstasy before their deaths In this original study Christopher Lane shows why Victorian fiction conveys both the pleasure and anguish of intimacy Examining works by Bulwer Lytton Swinburne Schreiner Hardy James Santayana and Forster he argues that these writers struggled with aspects of psychology that were undermining the utilitarian ethos of the Victorian age Lane discredits the conservative notion that Victorian literature expresses only a demand for repression and moral restraint But he also refutes historicist and Foucauldian approaches arguing that they dismiss the very idea of repression and end up denouncing psychoanalysis as complicit in various kinds of oppression These approaches Lane argues reduce Victorian literature to a drama about politics power and the ego Striving instead to reinvigorate discussions of fantasy and the unconscious Lane offers a clear often startling account of writers who grapple with the genuine complexities of love desire and friendship

Queer Forster Robert K. Martin,George

Piggford,1997-11-24 This groundbreaking volume presents a radical revision of gay criticism and focuses on E M Forster s place in the emerging field of queer studies Many previous critics of Forster downplayed his homosexuality or read Forster naively in terms of gay liberation This collection situates Forster within the Bloomsbury Group and examines his relations to major figures such as Henry James Edward Carpenter and Virginia Woolf Particular attention is paid to Forster s several accounts of India and their troubled relation to the British colonial enterprise Analyzing a wide range of Forster s work the authors examine material from Forster s undergraduate writings to stories written more than a half century later A landmark book for the study of gender in literature *Queer Forster* brings the terms queer and gay into conversation opening up a dialogue on wider dimensions of theory and allowing a major revaluation of modernist inventions of sexual identity

Romance Novel Pamela Regis,2013-08-31 The romance novel has the strange distinction of being the most popular but least respected of literary genres While it remains consistently dominant in bookstores and on best seller lists it is also widely dismissed by the critical community Scholars have alleged that romance novels help create subservient readers who are

largely women by confining heroines to stories that ignore issues other than love and marriage Pamela Regis argues that such critical studies fail to take into consideration the personal choice of readers offer any true definition of the romance novel or discuss the nature and scope of the genre Presenting the counterclaim that the romance novel does not enslave women but on the contrary is about celebrating freedom and joy Regis offers a definition that provides critics with an expanded vocabulary for discussing a genre that is both classic and contemporary sexy and entertaining Taking the stance that the popular romance novel is a work of literature with a brilliant pedigree Regis asserts that it is also a very old stable form She traces the literary history of the romance novel from canonical works such as Richardson s Pamela through Austen s Pride and Prejudice Bront s Jane Eyre and E M Hull s The Sheik and then turns to more contemporary works such as the novels of Georgette Heyer Mary Stewart Janet Dailey Jayne Ann Krentz and Nora Roberts

Terrorism, Insurgency and Indian-English Literature, 1830-1947 Alex Tickell, 2013-06-17 This book is an interdisciplinary study of representations of terrorism and political violence in the fiction and journalism of colonial India Focusing on key historical episodes such as the Calcutta Black Hole the anti thuggee campaigns of the 1830s the 1857 rebellion and anti colonial terrorism in Edwardian London it argues that exceptional violence was integral to colonial sovereignty and that the threat of violence mutually defined discursive relations between colonizer and colonized Moving beyond previous studies of colonial discourse and drawing on contemporary analyses of terrorism Tickell examines texts by both colonial and Indian authors tracing their contending engagements with terrorizing violence in selected newspapers journals novels and short stories The study includes readings of several significant early Indian English works for the first time from dissident periodicals like Hurrish Chunder Mookerjis Hindoo Patriot 1856 66 and Shyamji Krishnavarmas Indian Sociologist 1905 9 to neglected fictions such as Kylas Dutts parable of anti colonial rebellion Forty Eight Hours of the Year 1945 1845 and Sarath Kumar Ghosh s The Prince of Destiny 1909 These are examined alongside works by better known Anglo Indian authors such as Philip Meadows Taylor s Confessions of a Thug 1838 Flora Annie Steel s On the Face of the Waters 1897 Rudyard Kipling s short fictions and novels by Edmund Candler and E M Forster The study concludes with an analysis of Indian English fiction of the 1930s notably Mulk Raj Anand s Untouchable 1935 and goes on to read Gandhis philosophy of ahimsa non violence as a strategic response to a colonial and nationalist terror politics
