The Modern Invention of Medieval Music Daniel Leech-Wilkinson, 2002-10-17 Medieval music has been made and remade over the past two hundred years For the nineteenth century it was vocal without instrumental accompaniment but with barbarous harmony that no one could have wished to hear For most of the twentieth century it was instrumentally accompanied increasingly colourful and increasingly enjoyed At the height of its popularity it sustained an industry of players and instrument makers all engaged in recreating an apparently medieval performance practice During the 1980s it became vocal once more exchanging colour and contrast for cleanliness and beauty But what happens to produce such radical changes of perspective And what can we learn from them about the way we interact with the past How much is really known about the way medieval music sounded Or have modern beliefs been formed and sustained less by evidence than the personalities of scholars and performers their ideologies and their musical tastes

Musikwissenschaft 1900-1930 Wolfgang Auhagen, Wolfgang Hirschmann, Tomi Mäkelä, 2017-07-03 Die europäische Musikwissenschaft der dieser Band mit einem mitteleuropäischen Schwerpunkt gewidmet ist wandelte sich in den ersten drei Jahrzehnten des 20. Jahrhunderts von einer durch charismatische Akademiker geprägten Forschungslandschaft zu einem institutionell etablierten Wissenschaftsfach. Je nach Region legitimierte sich das Fach unterschiedlich an Universitäten, Konservatorien und Forschungsinstituten. Die Differenzierung der Fragestellungen in Forschung und Lehre, die Methodologie und das Verhältnis zum politischen und kulturellen Umfeld wiesen in dieser frühen Phase der Fachgeschichte sowohl Parallelen als auch Spuren regionaler Eigenständigkeit auf. Geschichte der musikalischen Interpretation im 19. und 20. Jahrhundert, Band 1: Ästhetik - Ideen Thomas Ertelt, Heinz von Loesch, 2019-05-14 Dies ist die erste große zusammenfassende Darstellung der Geschichte der musikalischen Interpretation in den letzten beiden Jahrhunderten. Für das

20. Jahrhundert gibt es eine solche bislang überhaupt noch nicht für das 19. Jahrhundert ist die Untersuchung deshalb so aufschlussreich, weil sich hier Interpretation im engeren Sinne erst herausbildet und die Begriffs- und Ideengeschichte ihren Ausgangspunkt nimmt. Durch diese Zusammenschau lassen sich Entwicklungen bis heute historisch einordnen und verstehen. Erstmals liegt mit dem Hermann Hesse Handbuch ein umfassend informierendes Nachschlagewerk zu diesem faszinierenden Autor vor. Hermann Hesse 1877-1962 war und ist ein literarisches Phänomen eigener Ordnung. Aus dem Geist der Symbolromantik und des lyrischen Impressionismus hervorgegangen, hat sein Werk in den ersten Jahrzehnten des 20. Jahrhunderts vor allem mit Künstler Erzählungen und Coming-of-Age Romanen wie dem Peter Camenzind, dem Demian und später dem Steppenwolf die Wertschätzung einer begeisterten Leserschaft erreicht. Ein internationaler Höhenflug war seiner indischen Siddhartha-Figur postum durch die US-amerikanische Hippiebewegung der späten 1960er Jahre beschieden. Hesses langlebige Popularität, die ihn neben Brecht zu einer frühen Gallionsfigur des Suhrkamp-Programms werden ließ, traf im intellektuellen Feuilleton und in der akademischen Welt oftmals auf eher abschätzige Beurteilungen.
