The Structural Allegory John Fekete, 1984 The Structural Allegory was first published in 1984 Minnesota Archive Editions uses digital technology to make long unavailable books once again accessible and are published unaltered from the original University of Minnesota Press editions The radical questions raised by Saussure Barthes Foucault Levi Strauss and others have had an enormous impact on Anglo American literary and cultural studies over the past twenty years John Fekete argues that we can see this strategic development of French thought in terms of what he calls the structural allegory Structuralism proper has given way to the currently dominant model of post structuralism yet we remain uncertain of the practical orientations favored by thinkers associated with both phases of the movement With the aim of uncovering the legacy of the structural tradition the essays in this volume survey key French thinkers including some not well known in the Anglo American context Baudrillard and Castoriadis The essays are reconstructive not deconstructive in character scholarly in method and ecumenical in spirit While the structural allegory emerges from this critical analysis as an inescapable intellectual paradigm analogous to the transformations in quantum physics and modern biology the authors argue that it merits admiration and reservation in equal measure

Close Listening Charles Bernstein, 1998-04-30 Close Listening brings together seventeen strikingly original essays especially written for this volume on the poetry reading the sound of poetry and the visual performance of poetry While the performance of poetry is as old as poetry itself critical attention to modern and postmodern poetry performance has been surprisingly slight This volume featuring work by critics and poets such as Marjorie Perloff Susan Stewart Johanna Drucker Dennis Tedlock and Susan Howe is the first comprehensive introduction to the ways in which twentieth century poetry has been practiced as a performance art From the performance styles of individual poets and types of poetry to the relation of sound to meaning from historical and social approaches to poetry readings to new imaginations of prosody the entries gathered here investigate a compelling range of topics for anyone interested in poetry Taken together these essays encourage new forms of close listenings not only to the printed text of poems but also to tapes performances and other expressions of the sounded and visualized word The time is right for such a

Reinventing Allegory Theresa M. Kelley, 1997-07-24 First published in 1997 Reinventing Allegory asks how and why allegory has survived as a literary mode from the late Renaissance to the postmodern present Three chapters on Romanticism including one on the painter J M W Turner present this era as the pivotal moment in allegory's modern survival

Other chapters describe larger historical and philosophical contexts including classical rhetoric and Spenser Milton and seventeenth century rhetoric Neoclassical distrust of allegory and recent theory and metafiction By using a series of key historical moments to define the special character of modern allegory this study offers an important framework for assessing allegory's role in contemporary literary culture

Allegory and Ideology Fredric Jameson, 2019-05-07 Fredric Jameson takes on the allegorical form Works do not have meanings they soak up meanings a work is a machine for libidinal investments including the political kind It is a process that sorts incommensurabilities and registers contradictions which is not the same as solving them The inevitable and welcome conflict of interpretations a discursive ideological struggle therefore needs to be supplemented by an account of this simultaneous processing of multiple meanings rather than an abandonment to liberal pluralisms and tolerant or intolerant relativisms This is not a book about method but it does propose a dialectic capable of holding together in one breath the heterogeneities that reflect our biological individualities our submersion in collective history and class struggle and our alienation to a disembodied new world of information and abstraction Eschewing the arid secularities of philosophy Walter Benjamin once recommended the alternative of the rich figurality of an older theology in that spirit we here return to the antiquated Ptolemaic systems of ancient allegory and its multiple levels a proposal first sketched out in *The Political Unconscious* it is tested against the epic complexities of the overtly allegorical works of Dante Spenser and the Goethe of *Faust II* as well as symphonic form in music and the structure of the novel postmodern as well as Third World about which a notorious essay on National Allegory is here reprinted with a theoretical commentary and an allegorical history of emotion is meanwhile rehearsed from its contemporary geopolitical context

Poetry, Symbol, and Allegory Simon Brittan, 2003 Dealing with poetry is frequently problematic for the university teacher and student although undergraduates are usually responsive to discussions about drama and prose poetry often silences the classroom Unless a poem provides references easily applicable to their own lives many students feel they can't relate to the piece and are stymied In particular allegorical poetry produces tensions among the desire to find the meanings of the poet's symbolism the fear of voicing a wrong interpretation and a natural objection to perceived restrictions on interpretive freedom Poetry Symbol and Allegory eases that dilemma by providing a historical overview of theories of interpretation as they apply to symbol and allegory in poetry thereby reclaiming valuable and useful methods of analyzing poems Beginning with Plato and Aristotle Simon Brittan moves from classical theory to the lesser known medieval exegetical theories of such notables as Augustine Aquinas and Origen addresses theory pertaining to Renaissance Italy and Dante English theory of the Middle Ages the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries and the Romantic period and concludes by weighing the poetry of T E Hulme T S Eliot and Ezra Pound on the larger historical scale of literary theory By acknowledging interpretive theories of the past Brittan provides a proper historical frame of reference in which today's student can better understand figurative language in poetry Simon Brittan is an independent scholar who divides his time between England and

Michigan He has taught at the University of East Anglia and in the Department for Continuing Education at the University of Oxford and written for Renaissance Forum the Times Literary Supplement and Gravesiana

Mirages and Mad Beliefs Christopher Prendergast, 2013-07-21 Marcel Proust was long the object of a cult in which the main point of reading his great novel *In Search of Lost Time* was to find with its narrator a redemptive epiphany in a pastry and a cup of lime blossom tea We now live in less confident times in ways that place great strain on the assumptions and beliefs that made those earlier readings possible This has led to a new manner of reading Proust against the grain In *Mirages and Mad Beliefs* Christopher Prendergast argues the case differently with the grain on the basis that Proust himself was prey to self doubt and found numerous if indirect ways of letting us know Prendergast traces in detail the locations and forms of a quietly nondogmatic yet insistently skeptical voice that questions the redemptive aesthetic the novel is so often taken to celebrate bringing the reader to wonder whether that aesthetic is but another instance of the mirage or the mad belief that in other guises figures prominently in *In Search of Lost Time* In tracing the modalities of this self pressuring voice Prendergast ranges far and wide across a multiplicity of ideas themes sources and stylistic registers in Proust's literary thought and writing practice attentive at every point to inflections of detail in a sustained account of Proust the skeptic for the contemporary reader

Allegory and the Work of Melancholy Jeremy Tambling, 2021-11-08 Written using critical theory especially by Walter Benjamin Blanchot and Derrida *Allegory and the Work of Melancholy* The Late Medieval and Shakespeare reads medieval and early modern texts exploring allegory within texts allegorical readings of texts and melancholy in texts Authors studied are Langland and Chaucer Hoccleve on his madness Lydgate and Henryson Shakespeare's first tetralogy the three parts of Henry VI and Richard III conclude this investigation of death mourning madness and of complaint Benjamin's writings on allegory inspire this linking which also considers Dürer Baldung and Holbein and the dance of the dead motifs The study sees subjectivity created as obsessional paranoid and links melancholia madness and allegorical creation where parts of the subject are split off from each other and speak as wholes Allegory and melancholy are two modes a state of writing and a state of being where the subject fragments or disappears These texts are aware of the power of death within writing which makes them fascinating The book will appeal to readers of literature from the medieval to the Baroque and to those interested in critical theory and histories of visual culture
