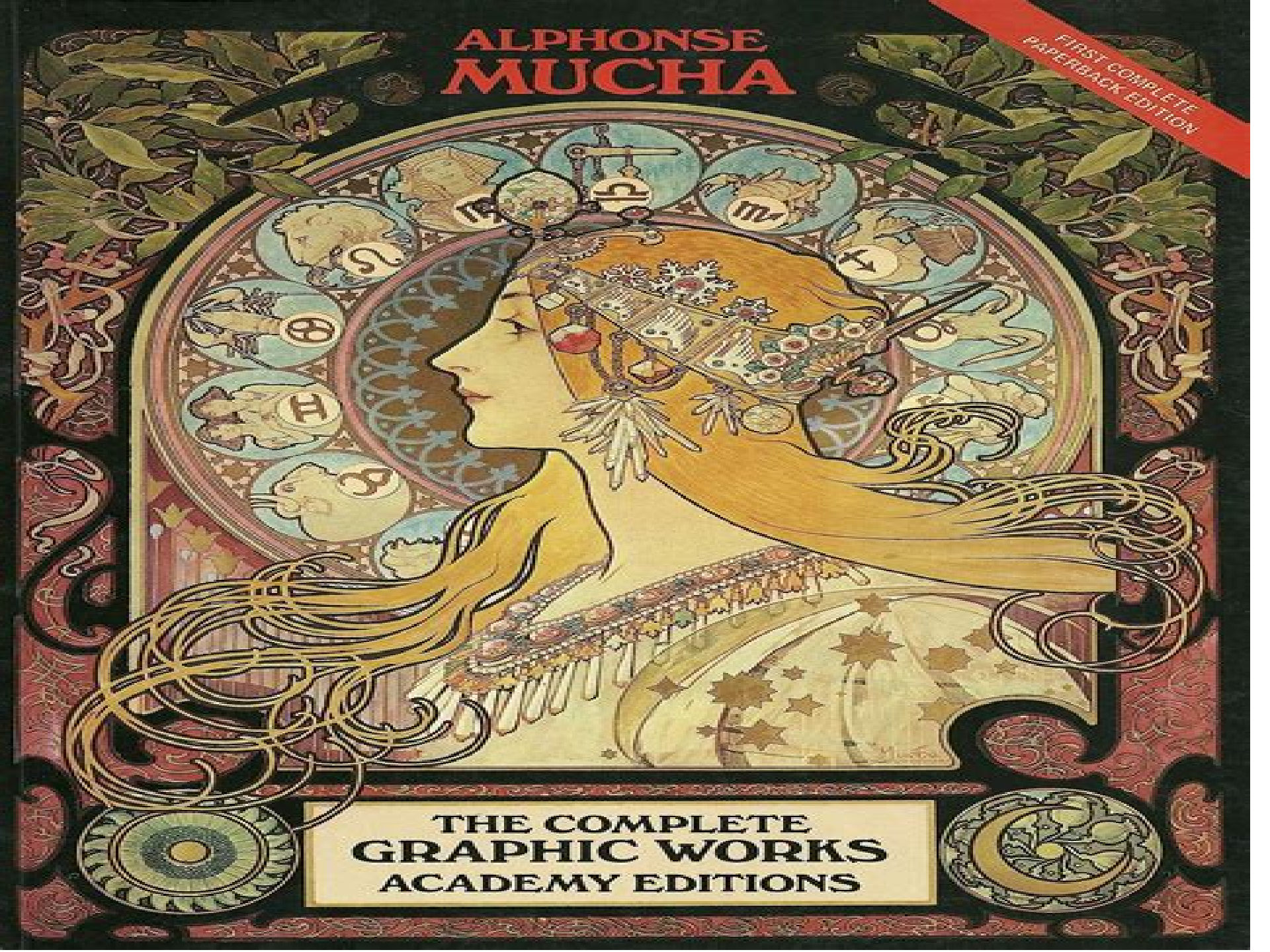

Vogler,1979-01-01 269 copyright free reproductions of etchings woodcuts eight in full color **Alphonse Mucha** Alphonse Mucha,1993 *Perfume on the Page in Nineteenth-Century France* Cheryl Krueger,2023-06-26 Despite long standing assertions that languages including French and English cannot sufficiently communicate the experience of smell much of France s nineteenth century literature has gained praise for its memorable evocation of odours As French perfume was industrialized democratized cosmeticized and feminized in the nineteenth century stories of fragrant scent trails aligned perfume with toxic behaviour and viewed a woman s scent as something alluring but also something to be controlled Drawing on a wealth of resources *Perfume on the Page in Nineteenth Century France* explores how fiction and related writing on olfaction meet permeate and illuminate one another The book examines medical tracts letters manuscripts posters print advertisements magazine articles perfume manuals etiquette books interviews and encounters with fragrant materials themselves Cheryl Krueger explores how the olfactory language of a novel or poem conveys the distinctiveness of a text its unique relationship to language its style and its ways of engaging the reader its signature scent Shedding light on the French perfume culture that we know today *Perfume on the Page in Nineteenth Century France* follows the scent trails that ultimately challenge us to read perfume and literature in new ways *Wide Awake in Slumberland* Katherine Roeder,2014-03-25 Cartoonist Winsor McCay 1869 1934 is rightfully celebrated for the skillful draftmanship and inventive design sense he displayed in the comic strips Little Nemo in Slumberland and Dream of the Rarebit Fiend McCay crafted narratives of anticipation abundance and unfulfilled longing This book explores McCay s interest in dream imagery in relation to the larger preoccupation with fantasy that dominated the popular culture of early twentieth century urban America McCay s role as a pioneer of early comics has been documented yet no existing study approaches him and his work from an art historical perspective giving close readings of individual artworks while situating his output within the larger visual culture and the rise of modernism From circus posters and vaudeville skits to department store window displays and amusement park rides McCay found fantastical inspiration in New York City s burgeoning entertainment and retail districts *Wide Awake in Slumberland* connects McCay s work to relevant children s literature advertising architecture and motion pictures in order to demonstrate the artist s sophisticated blending and remixing of multiple forms from mass culture Studying this interconnection in McCay s work and by extension the work of other early twentieth century cartoonists Roeder traces the web of relationships connecting fantasy leisure and consumption Readings of McCay s drawings and the eighty one black and white and color illustrations reveal a man who was both a ready

Art Nouveau and the Classical Tradition Richard Warren, 2019-05-30 Art Nouveau was a style for a new age but it was also one that continued to look back to the past This new study shows how in expressing many of their most essential concerns sexuality death and the nature of art its artists drew heavily upon classical literature and the iconography of classical art It challenges the conventional view that Art Nouveau s adherents turned their backs on Classicism in their quest for new forms Across Europe and North America artists continued to turn back to the ancient world and in particular to Greece for the vitality with which they sought to infuse their creations The works of many well known artists are considered through this prism including those of Gustav Klimt Aubrey Beardsley and Louis Comfort Tiffany But breaking new ground in its comparative approach this study also considers some of the movement s less well known painters sculptors jewellers and architects including in central and eastern Europe and their use of classical iconography to express new ideas of nationhood Across the world while Art Nouveau was a plural style drawing on multiple influences the Classics remained a key artistic vocabulary for its artists whether blended with Orientalist and other iconographies or preserving the purity of classical form

Sargent Portrait Drawings John Singer Sargent, Trevor J. Fairbrother, 1983-01-01 Portraiture is a demanding art requiring the artist to capture a likeness and render it revealing some hint of the personality behind the image A two pronged task it requires great technical skill and an intuitive eye In both these respects John Singer Sargent stands out as a portrait artist of major stature Born in 1856 in Florence of American parents Sargent showed artistic aptitude at an early age and was enrolled at the Academia delle Belle Arti in that city Later he studied with Parisian artist Carolus Duran acquiring the loose painterly style for which he is renowned International acclaim as a portrait artist came early in his life and followed him throughout his career Sargent s portraits done in oil are well known they appear in major museums throughout the world A lesser known but no less respected aspect of his oeuvre his portrait drawings are the focus of this collection Included here are early works in pencil and pastels and later renderings in charcoal a medium Sargent favored after 1910 They have been selected from both public and private collections by art historian Trevor J Fairbrother and attest to Sargent s technical skill versatility and dexterity in three different mediums In addition these works reveal Sargent s ability to treat a diverse group of subjects he handles the languorous beauties of the Edwardian age members of the aristocracy and the great literary and artistic figures of his day with equal virtuosity capturing their characteristic mood and style This collection includes portraits of Lord and Lady Spencer Henry James William Butler Yeats Vaslav Nijinsky Tamara Karsavina Dame Ethel Smyth and Jascha Heifetz Artists students historians and lovers of portraiture will appreciate this selection of drawings by Sargent Anyone interested in trying his hand at portraiture will find this volume both instructional and inspirational **The Art of**
