Olsen, 2012 The purpose of this chapter is to share some general thoughts about teaching the broad undergraduate public economics course that might be helpful to new teachers of this course and some ideas about dealing with particular topics that might be useful to even experienced teachers Like others who teach courses in the United States my coverage of particular programs is limited to expenditure programs and taxes in the US However the advice in this chapter is not US centric Public economics is the only broad field devoted entirely to public policy Although other fields deal with particular public policies that fit naturally within their scope such as minimum wage laws labor economics tariffs international economics and anti trust policy industrial organization they focus primarily on understanding behavior in private markets The coverage of public policies in undergraduate public economics courses is much broader Public economics courses focus on the justifications for a wide range of government activities and the effects of major expenditure programs and taxes with some attention to the behavior of actors in the political process The broad goal of my general undergraduate public economics course is to develop each
