houses have extended to more accessible luxury products and as a result realize now a substantial part of sales in both clothing and accessories But also the demand side has been substantially changing In 1899 the American economist Thorstein Veblen published the first proper study of consumerism in which he identified and analysed the traditional luxury customer group which he called leisure class It was not until the 1980s that the leisure class was joined by newly rich and occasional customers from the middle class On the one hand the luxury industry has expanded to more accessible products and to new geographical markets and on the other hand a growth in wealth of the Western industrialized nations has increased purchase of luxury goods These mostly fundamental changes have challenged and will furthermore challenge the fashion houses and the ability to establish a competitive advantage The objective of this thesis is gaining a thorough understanding of the luxury clothing and accessories sector by elaborating on
