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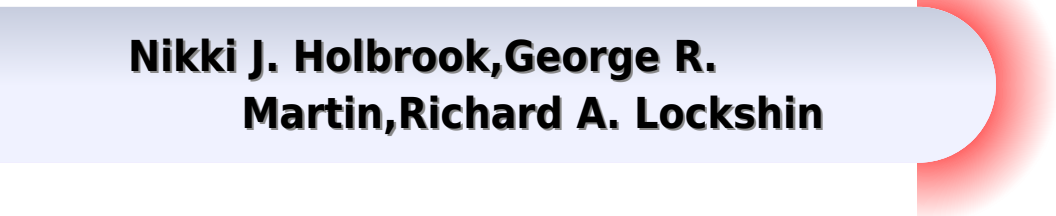

Roth, 1983      *Protein Metabolism and Homeostasis in Aging* Nektarios Tavernarakis, 2011-01-11 Aging is loosely defined as the accumulation of changes in an organism over time At the cellular level such changes are distinct and multidimensional DNA replication ceases cells stop dividing they become senescent and eventually die DNA metabolism and chromosomal maintenance together with protein metabolism are critical in the aging process The focus of this book is on the role of protein metabolism and homeostasis in aging An overview is provided of the current knowledge in the area including protein synthesis accuracy and repair post translational modifications degradation and turnover and how they define and influence aging The chapters mainly focus on well characterised factors and pathways but new areas are also presented where associations with aging are just being elucidated by current experimental data Protein turnover the balance between protein synthesis and protein degradation are carefully maintained in healthy cells Chapters 1 and 2 illustrate that aging cells are characterised by alterations in the rate level and accuracy of protein synthesis compared to young ones and that mRNA translation essential for cell growth and survival is controlled at multiple levels The theory that growth and somatic maintenance are believed to be antagonistic processes is described in Chapter 3 inhibition of protein synthesis results in decreased rates of growth and development but also confers an extension of lifespan as shown for example by the effects of dietary restriction in various models organisms      **Aging Mechanisms II** Nozomu Mori, 2022-04-28 This book describes the recent advancement of basic research on the biology of aging and longevity studies in various organisms as well as the neurobiology of aging and neurodegeneration mechanisms Chapters present new findings and conceptual developments concerning the basic mechanisms of aging and longevity determination As a follow up volume to the previous book *Aging Mechanisms 2015* it overviews the rapid progress of aging research introducing new topics from leading laboratories in Japan Chapter contributors are selected based on recent scientific achievements on the mechanisms of aging in various model organisms including yeast worm *C. elegans* fly *Drosophila* mice and rats Chapters are ordered from the discussion on molecular and cellular levels to physiological and systemic levels The book also provides an overview of aging science in the region and helps readers quickly grasp who is doing what in this research area As the aging of population becomes an ever more pressing issue in Asia advancing the understanding of basic mechanisms of organism aging and longevity determination will be crucial to developing more effective therapies and protective strategies Researchers and graduate students in biomedical aging research will find this as a rich source of information and a stimulus to novel research directions      **Oxidative Stress and Aging** R.C. Mori, 2012-12-06 Oxidative stress and aging Over the past several years there has been an extraordinarily rapid growth in our knowledge of free radical chemistry and its possible involvement in both normal essential biology and age related disease and dysfunction Much of this growth in the traditionally separate sciences of chemistry and molecular gerontology occurred independently with little interaction or

communication between the scientists working in these two fields. In view of the growing maturity of the two fields and the potential importance of advancing our knowledge in the area of oxidative stress and aging, we perceived a critical need to organize an international conference: the First International Conference on Oxidative Stress and Aging in Hawaii in 1994, to bring together the world's leading scientists in the fields of reactive oxygen species and molecular gerontology. The objective of this conference was to provide a unique opportunity for scholars working in these two related and rapidly growing fields to participate in the exchange, integration and synthesis of new concepts and ideas, to engage in constructive criticism and to initiate new collaborative research projects. The conference focused on the molecular and cellular aspects of aging as related to oxidative stress. It was one of the largest and most comprehensive international conferences held in molecular gerontology. At this conference, a call was made for submission of papers to be used in the publication of a book covering the major contributions of the meeting.

The world population is rapidly aging; it is estimated that by 1950 around 17% of the population will be elderly. In this context, aging involves several physiological, psychological and highly complex social processes that vary from one person to another. For a long time, medical care for older adults has focused on treating chronic age-related diseases and their associated consequences. Recently, biomedical research brings a novel point of view to develop more effective interventions by targeting the aging process itself rather than separate conditions. One reason is because many people would consider it desirable if human life span could be extended. Indeed it is difficult not to be fascinated by tales of the life and death of people who have succeeded in living a very long life. Because of this we have placed at the head of this book the chapter by Perls et al on Centenarians and the Genetics of Longevity. Perls and his coauthors convincingly argue that while the average life expectancy might be mostly determined by environmental factors because the average person has an average genotype, extremely long life spans are genetically determined. Of course studying humans to uncover the genetics of aging is not ideal, not so much because one cannot easily perform experiments as because they live such a long time. This is why most of this book describes the current state of research with model organisms such as yeast, worms, flies, and mice. Jaswinski focuses on yeast and how metabolic activity and stress resistance affect the longevity of *Saccharomyces cerevisiae*. In the process he discusses the concept of aging as applied to a unicellular organism such as yeast and the importance of metabolism and stress resistance for aging in all organisms.
