PREFACE THE Author of this very practical treatise on Scotch Loch Fishing desires clearly that it may be of use to all who had it He does not pretend to have written anything new but to have attempted to put what he has to say in as readable a form as possible Everything in the way of the history and habits of fish has been studiously avoided and technicalities have been used as sparingly as possible The writing of this book has afforded him pleasure in his leisure moments and that pleasure would be much increased if he knew that the perusal of it would create any bond of sympathy between himself and the angling community in general This section is interleaved with blank sheets for the readers notes The Author need hardly say that any suggestions addressed to the case of the publishers will meet with consideration in a future edition We do not pretend to write or enlarge upon a new subject Much has been said and written and well said and written too on the art of fishing but loch fishing has been rather looked upon as a second rate performance and to dispel this idea is one of the objects for which this present treatise has been written Far be it from us to say anything against fishing lawfully practised in any form but many pent up in our large towns will bear us out when we say that on the whole a days loch fishing is the most convenient One great matter is that the loch fisher is dependent on nothing but enough wind to curl the water and on a large loch it is very seldom that a dead calm prevails all day and can make his arrangements for a day weeks beforehand whereas the stream fisher is dependent for a good take on the state of the water and however pleasant and easy it may be for one living near the banks of a good trout stream or river it is quite another matter to arrange for a days river fishing if one is looking forward to a holiday at a date some weeks ahead Providence may favour the expectant angler with a good day and the water in order but experience has taught most of us that the good days are in the minority and that as is the case with our rapid running streams such as many of our northern streams are the water is either too large or too small unless as previously remarked you live near at hand and can catch it at its best A common belief in regard to loch fishing is that the tyro and the experienced angler have nearly the same chance in fishing the one from the stern and the other from the bow of the same boat Of all the absurd beliefs as to loch fishing this is one of the most absurd Try it Give the tyro either end of the boat he likes give him a cast of ally flies he may fancy or even a cast similar to those which a crack may be using and if he catches one for every three the other has he may consider himself very lucky Of course there are lochs where the fish are not abundant and a beginner may come across as many as an older fisher but we speak of lochs where there are fish to be caught and where each has a fair chance Again it is said that the boatman has as much to do with catching trout in a loch as the angler Well we dont deny that In an untried loch it is necessary to have the guidance of a good boatman but the same argument holds good as to stream fishing Arthur

The Aesthetic and Decadent Movement of the late 19th century spawned the idea of Art for Art's Sake challenged aesthetic standards and shocked the bourgeoisie. From Walter Pater's study *The Renaissance to Salome* the truly decadent collaboration between Oscar Wilde and Aubrey Beardsley Karl Beckson has chosen a full spectrum of works that chronicle the British artistic achievement of the 1890s. In this revised edition of a classic anthology *The Ballad of Reading Gaol* has been included in its entirety the bibliography has been completely updated. Professor Beckson's notes and commentary have been expanded from the first edition published in 1966. The so-called Decadent or Aesthetic period remains one of the most interesting in the history of the arts. The poetry and prose of such writers as Yeats, Wilde, Symons, Johnson, Dowson, Barlas, Pater and others are included in this collection along with sixteen of Aubrey Beardsley's drawings.

Strangeness and Beauty: Volume 1, Ruskin to Swinburne Eric Warner, Graham Hough, 1983-04-07. This is a two-volume anthology of criticism of art and literature from approximately 1840 to 1910. The central purpose of the anthology is to show how Romantic ideas of art and imagination were transformed by a number of writers in the nineteenth century and became the fundamental premisses of modernist aesthetics. Volume 1 begins with the development of the Romantic idea of the artist-critic as preacher in the work of Ruskin whose aim was very much that of his Romantic forebears Blake and Wordsworth to awaken humanity to a greater spiritual perception. The volume also concerns itself with the transformation of this in works such as Arthur Hallam's essay on his friend Tennyson which is central to the writing of the Pre-Raphaelite Brotherhood and with the development of French Romanticism into the influential aesthetic movement of Symbolism in the work of Gautier and Baudelaire. The volumes comprise general introductions and introduction to individual extracts, full annotation and helpful guides to further reading.

hypothesis that they call upon the active participation of the reader in the production of meaning It has a twofold objective first it shows that Wilde s emphasis on the creative role of the audience in his critical writings makes him conceive the reader as a co creator in the construction of meaning Second it analyses the strategies which Wilde employs to impel the reader to collaborate in the creation of meaning of his literary works and casts light upon the social criticism derived from these The examination of Wilde s writings reveals how he gradually combined more sophisticated techniques that encouraged the reader s dynamic role with the progressive exploitation of self advertising strategies for professional purposes These allowed the commercial Oscar to make his works successful among the Victorian public without betraying the literary Wilde s aesthetic principles The present study re evaluates Wilde as a critic and as a writer It demonstrates that while Wilde the myth was ahead of his time in many ways Wilde the ARTIST anticipated in his aesthetic theory various themes which occupy contemporary literary theoreticians Thus it may contribute to give him the status he rightly deserves in the history of literature
